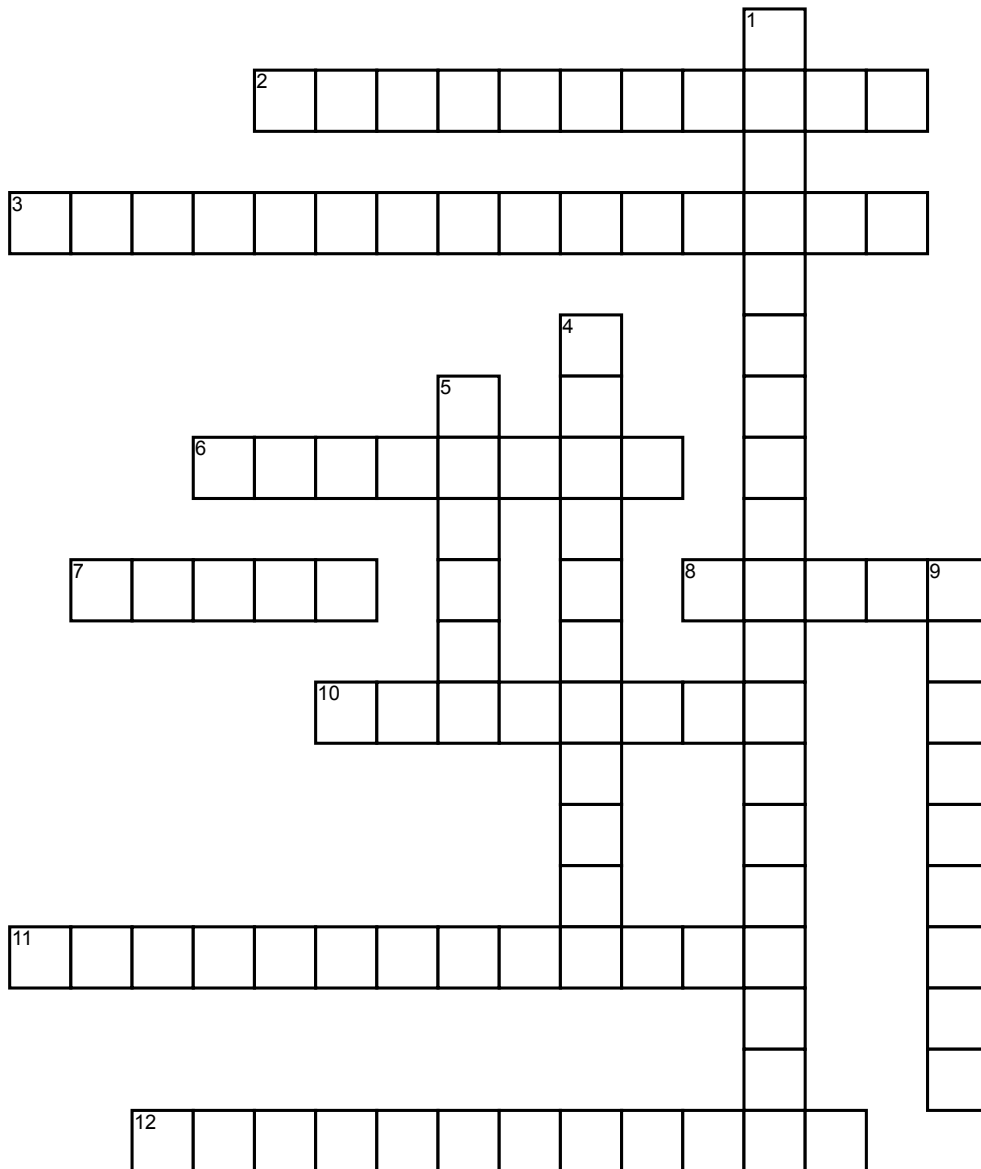


12 Powerful Words
