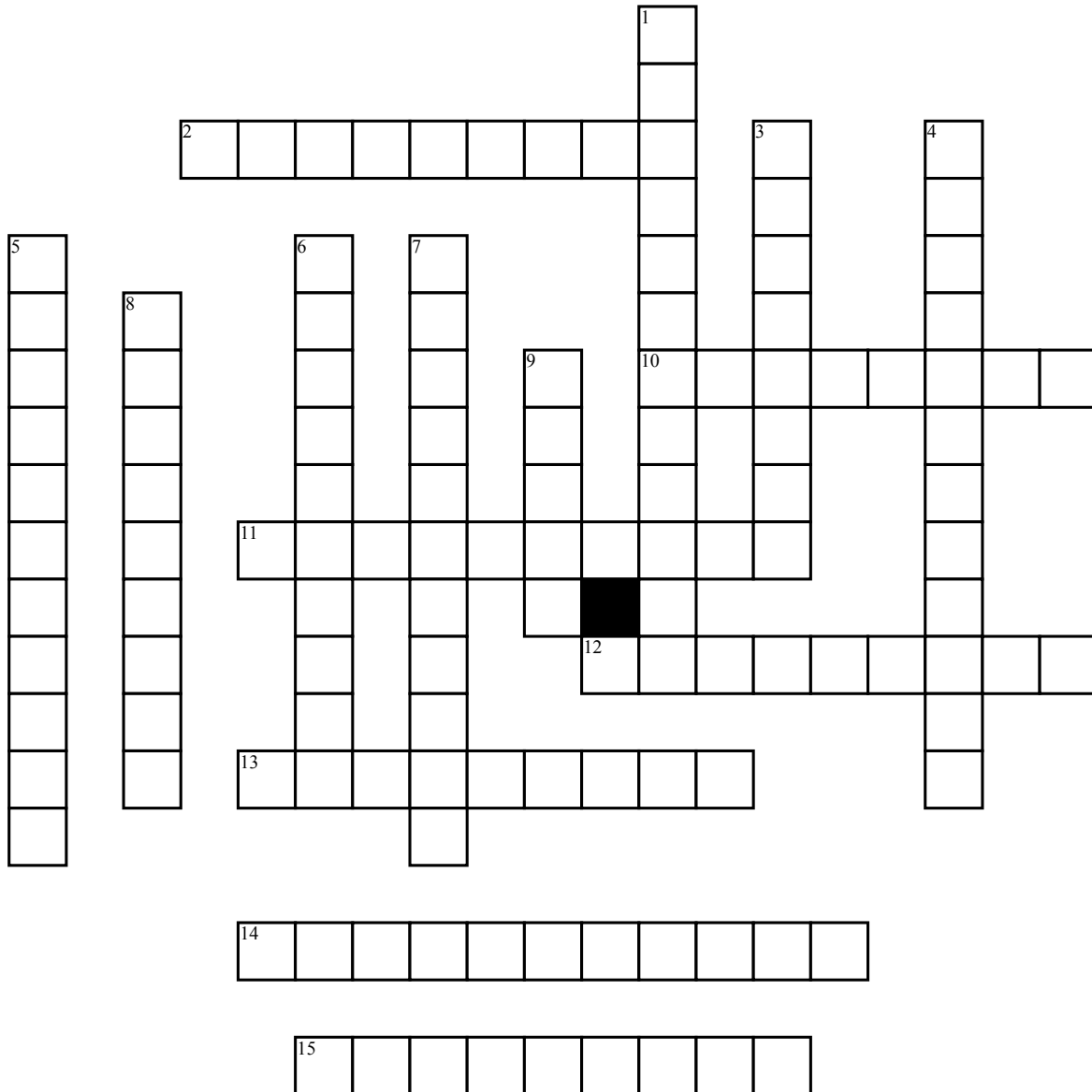


1408 Crossword Puzzle
