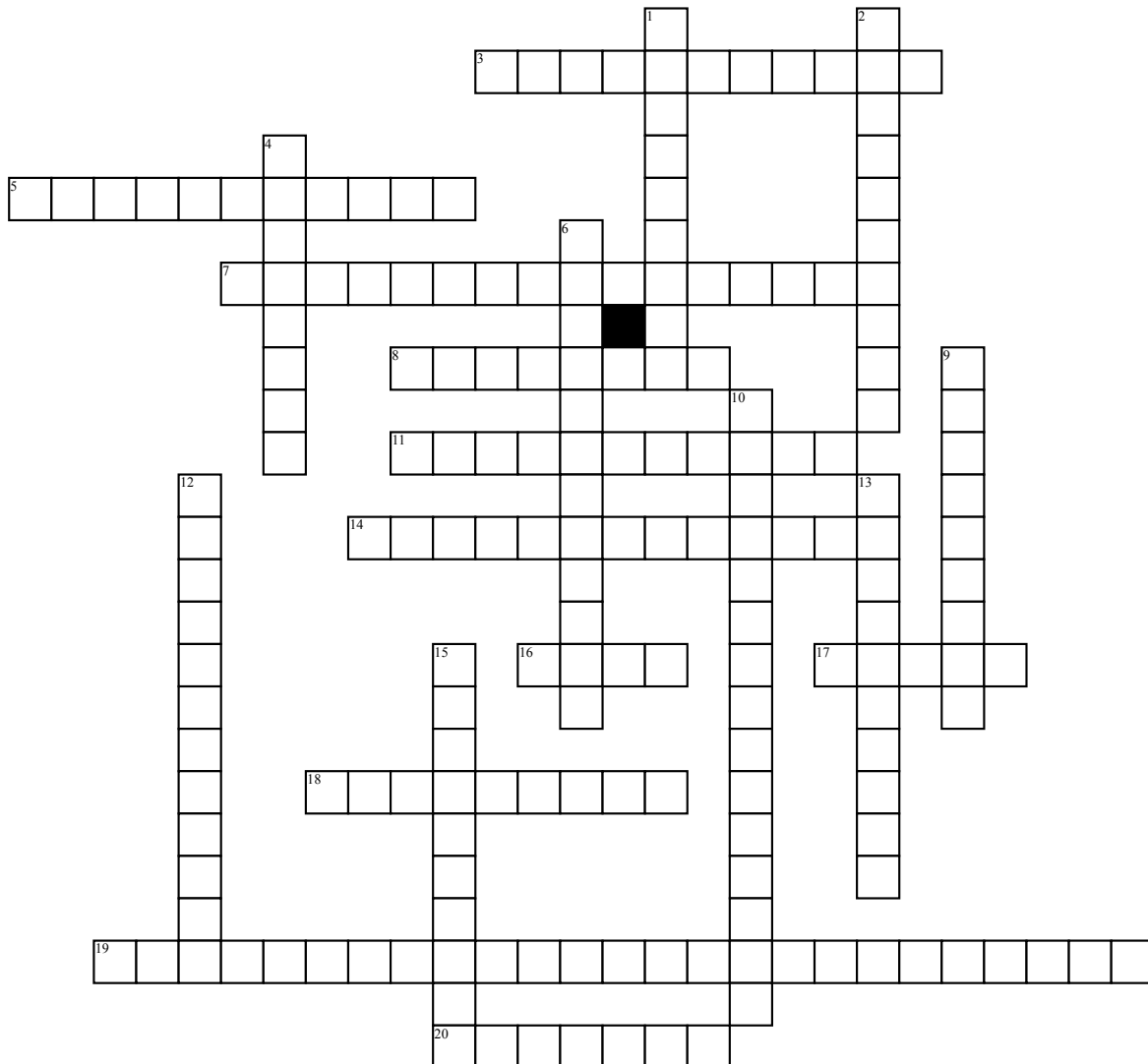


1920's Crossword puzzle
