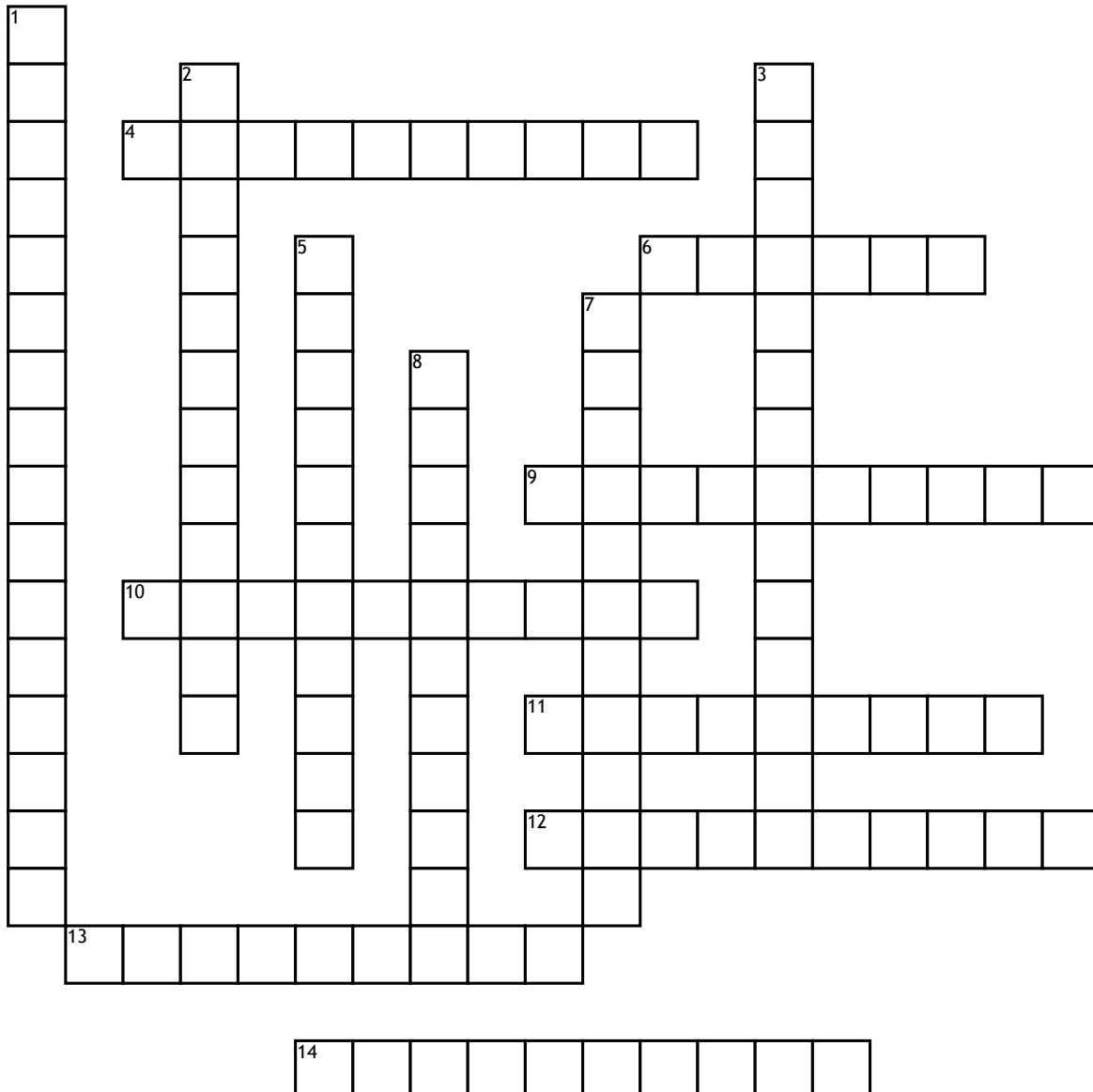

4. Coverage of additional anaerobic coverage in \_\_\_\_\_ pneumonia is often not needed unless there is evidence of lung abscess or empyema
