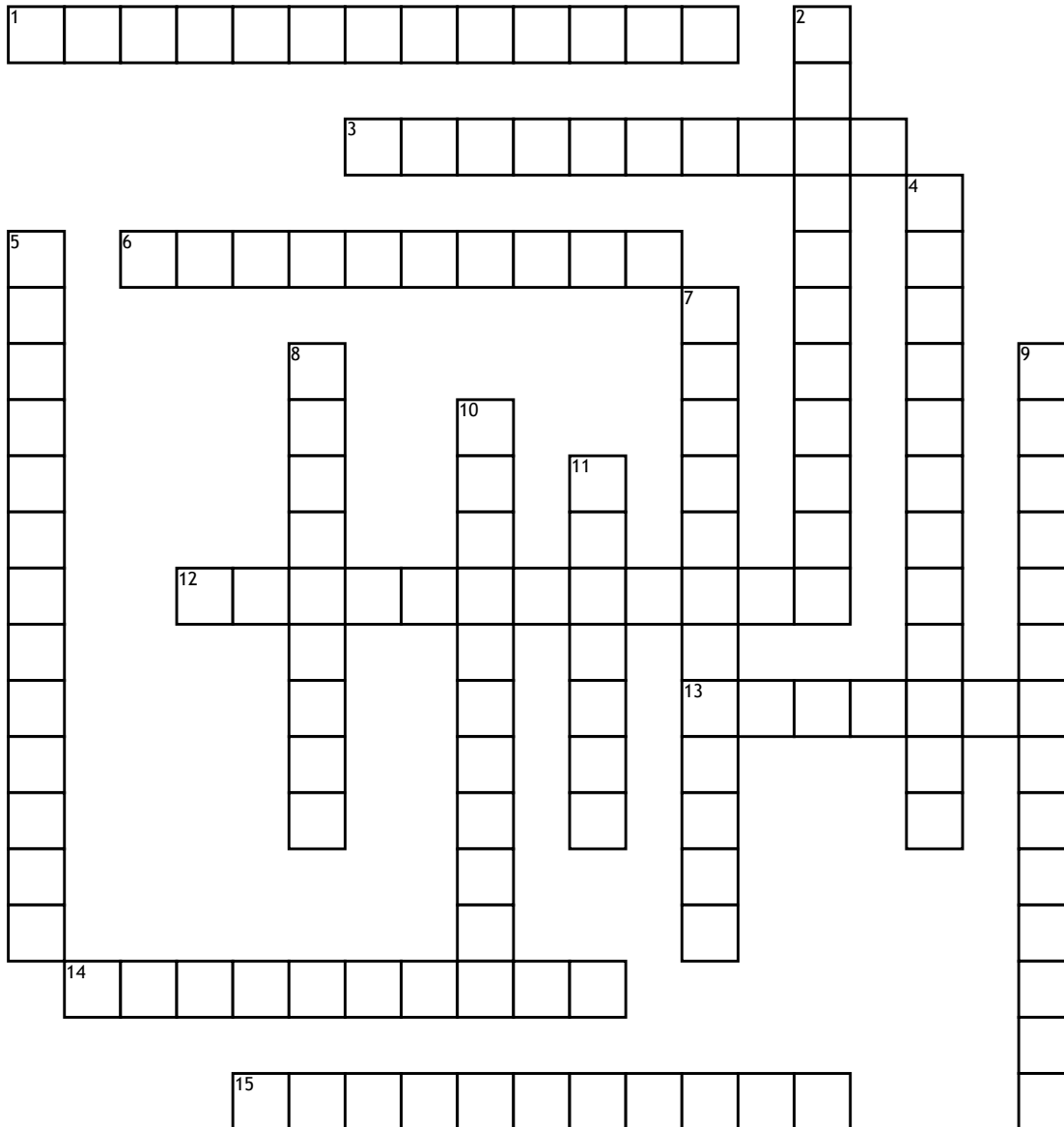


2.05 Respiratory Medical Terminology

1. aspiration of fluid from the chest
 3. acute or chronic inflammation of the bronchial tubes
 6. an instrument for measuring the volume of air entering and leaving the lungs
 12. a tubular endoscope that is inserted in to the larynx through the mouth and used for observing the interior of the larynx

13. diminished availability of oxygen to the body tissues
 14. nervous twitching of a muscle
 15. surgical procedure where a cut is made into the trachea and a tube is inserted to allow air to get into the lungs

2. plastic surgery of the nose
 4. spontaneous bleeding due to a disease of the blood
 5. an instrument for counting blood cells

7. collection of air or gas in the chests that causes part or all of a lung to collapse
 8. disease of the sebaceous glands characterized by excessive secretion of sebum
 9. fluid accumulation in the tissue and air spaces of the lungs
 10. a sound produced in percussion of the larynx when the glottis is open
 11. labored or difficulty breathing
