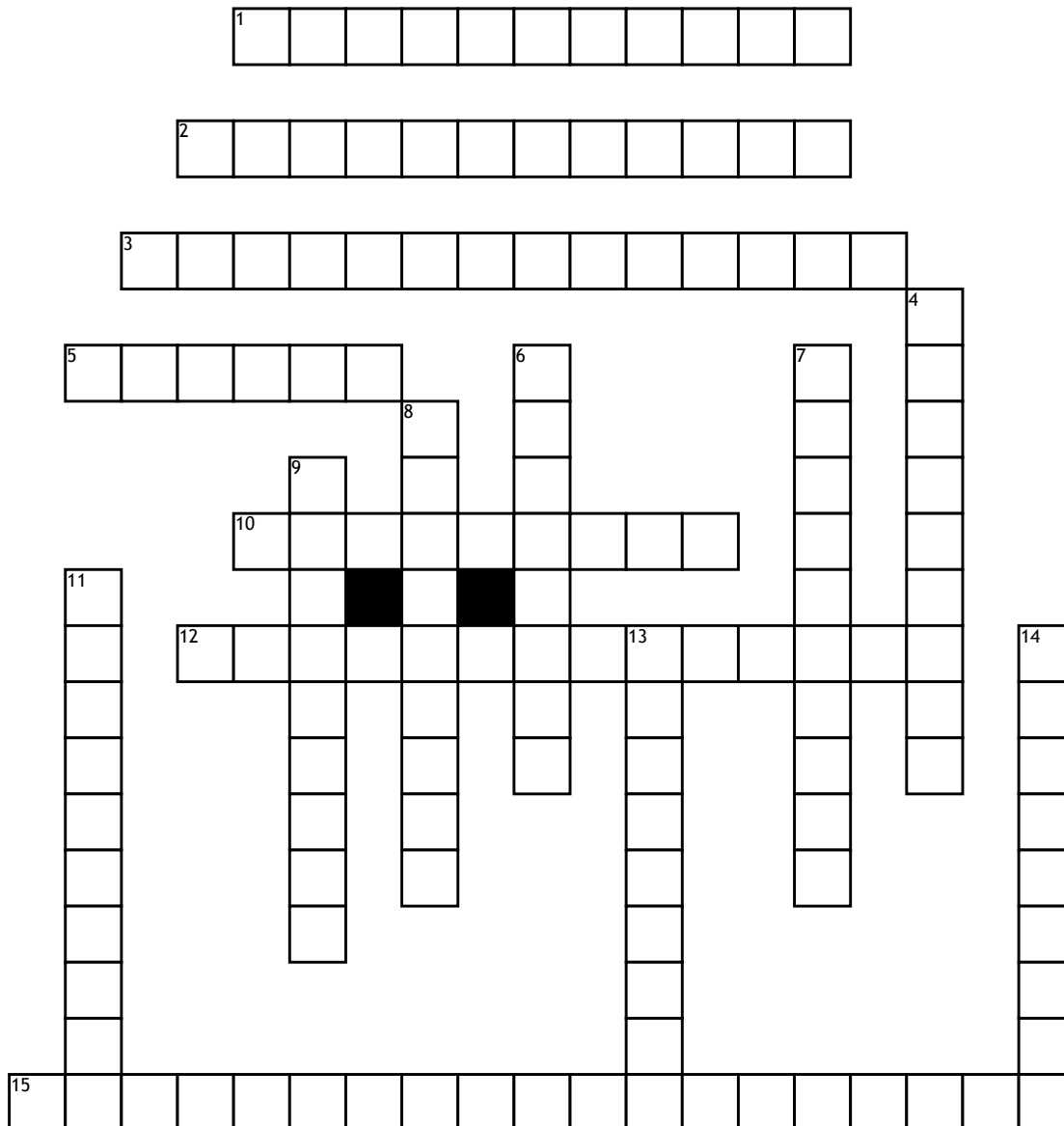


# 3.01 Nervous Medical Terminology -Noemie

1. imaging technique that uses electromagnetic radiation other than visible light, especially X-rays, to view the internal structure of a non-uniformly composed and opaque object such as the human body
2. medical practitioner specializing in the diagnosis and treatment of mental illness.
3. relating to or involving both the cranium and the cerebrum.
5. a specialized cell transmitting nerve impulses; a nerve cell.

10. healthcare professional, predominantly in the pre-hospital and out-of-hospital environment, and working mainly as part of emergency medical services, such as on an ambulance.

12. drooping eyelid.

15. loss of function of the lumbar plexus of the spinal canal below the termination of the spinal cord. CES is a lower motor neuron lesion.

11. tumor that forms on membranes that cover the brain and spinal cord just inside the skull.
