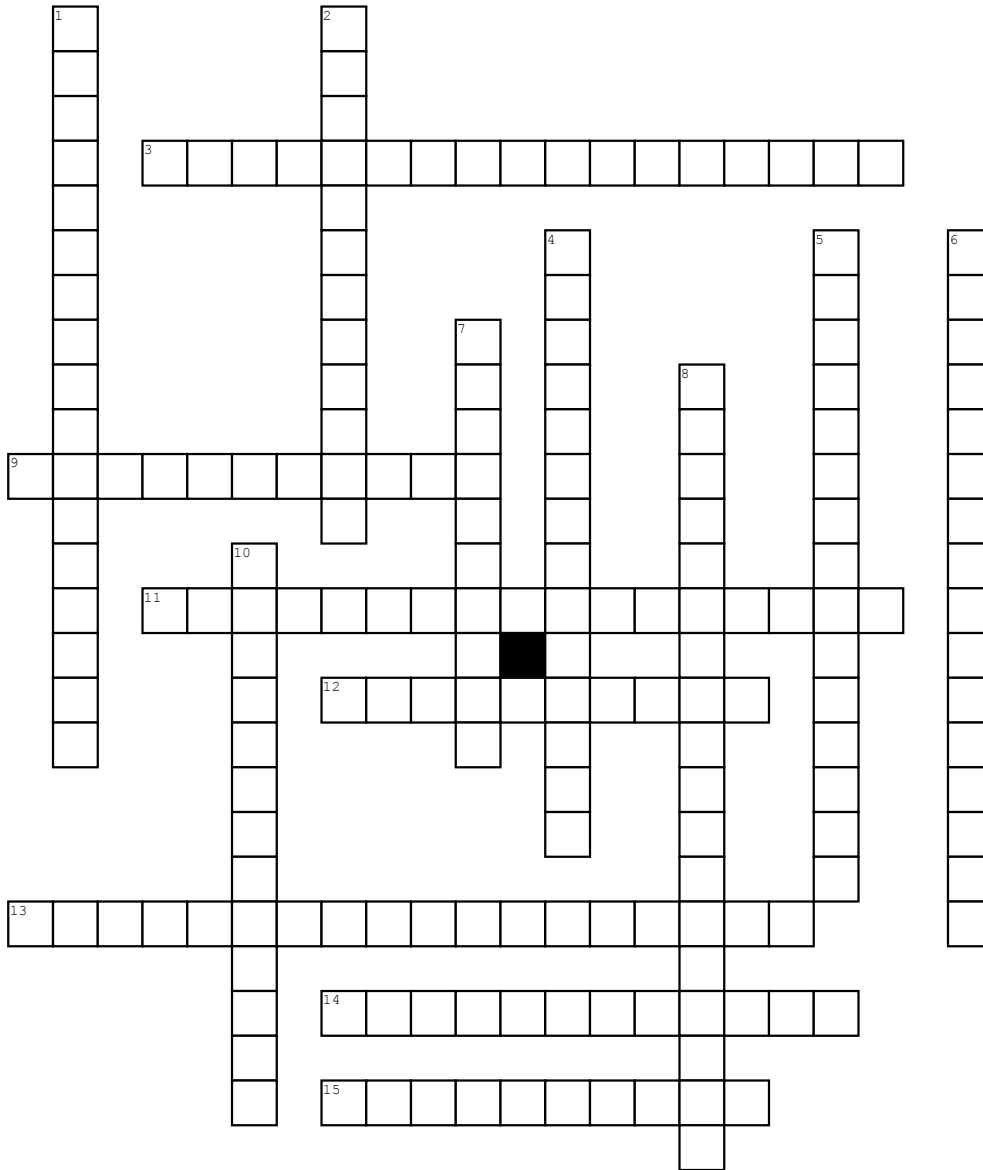


## 7 Principles of the Constitution Crossword Puzzle
