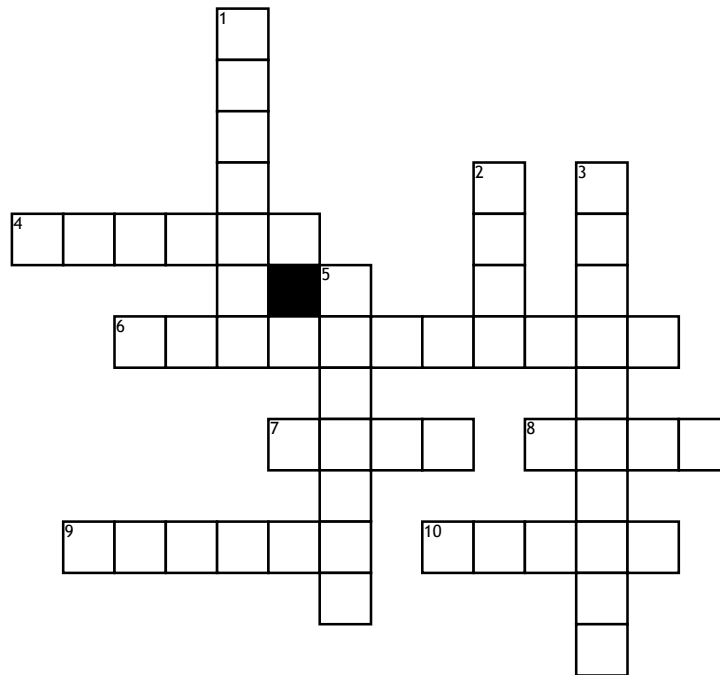


# 8A Vocabulary: Affixes, Roots, Stems
