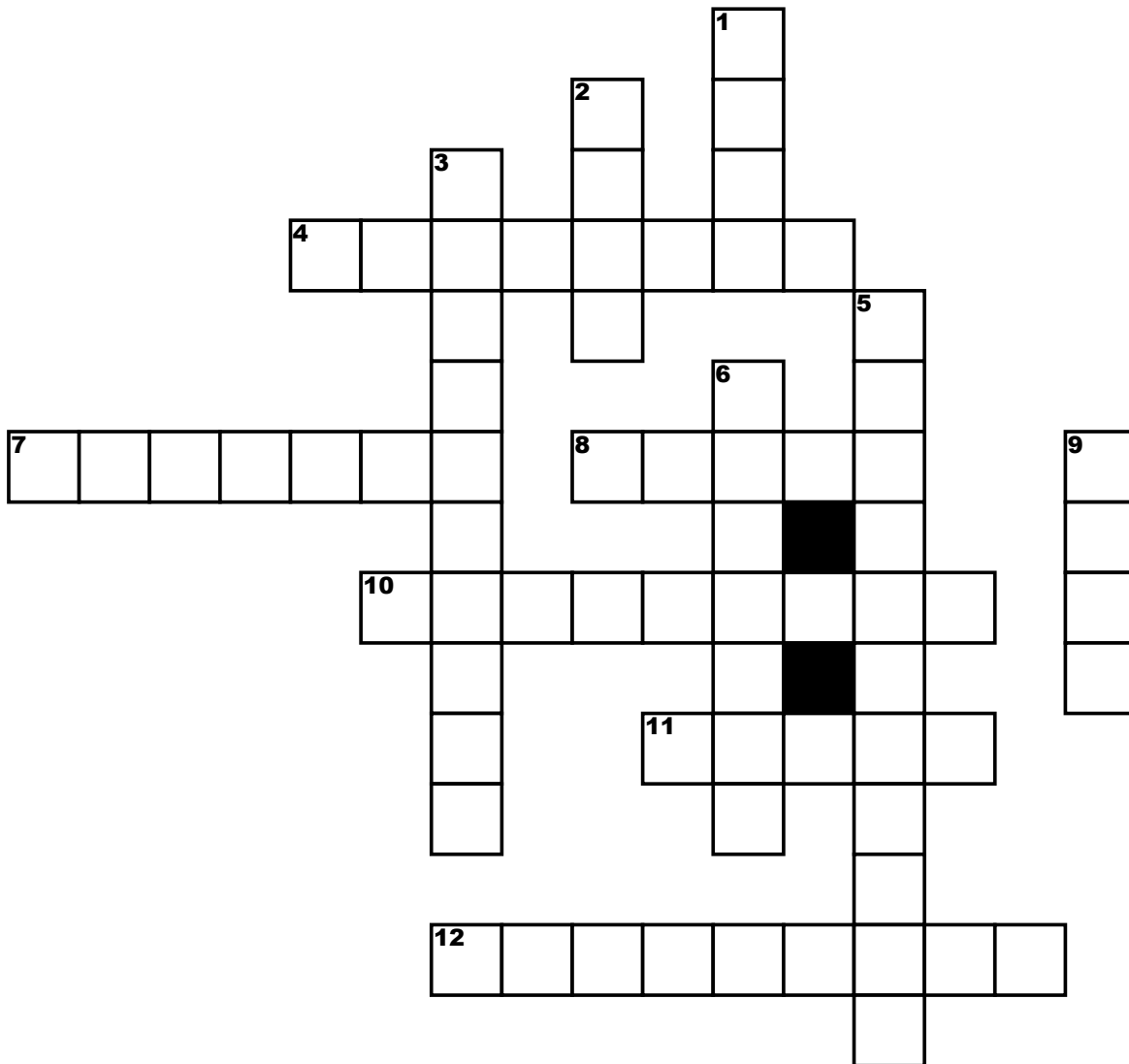


# ACTS
