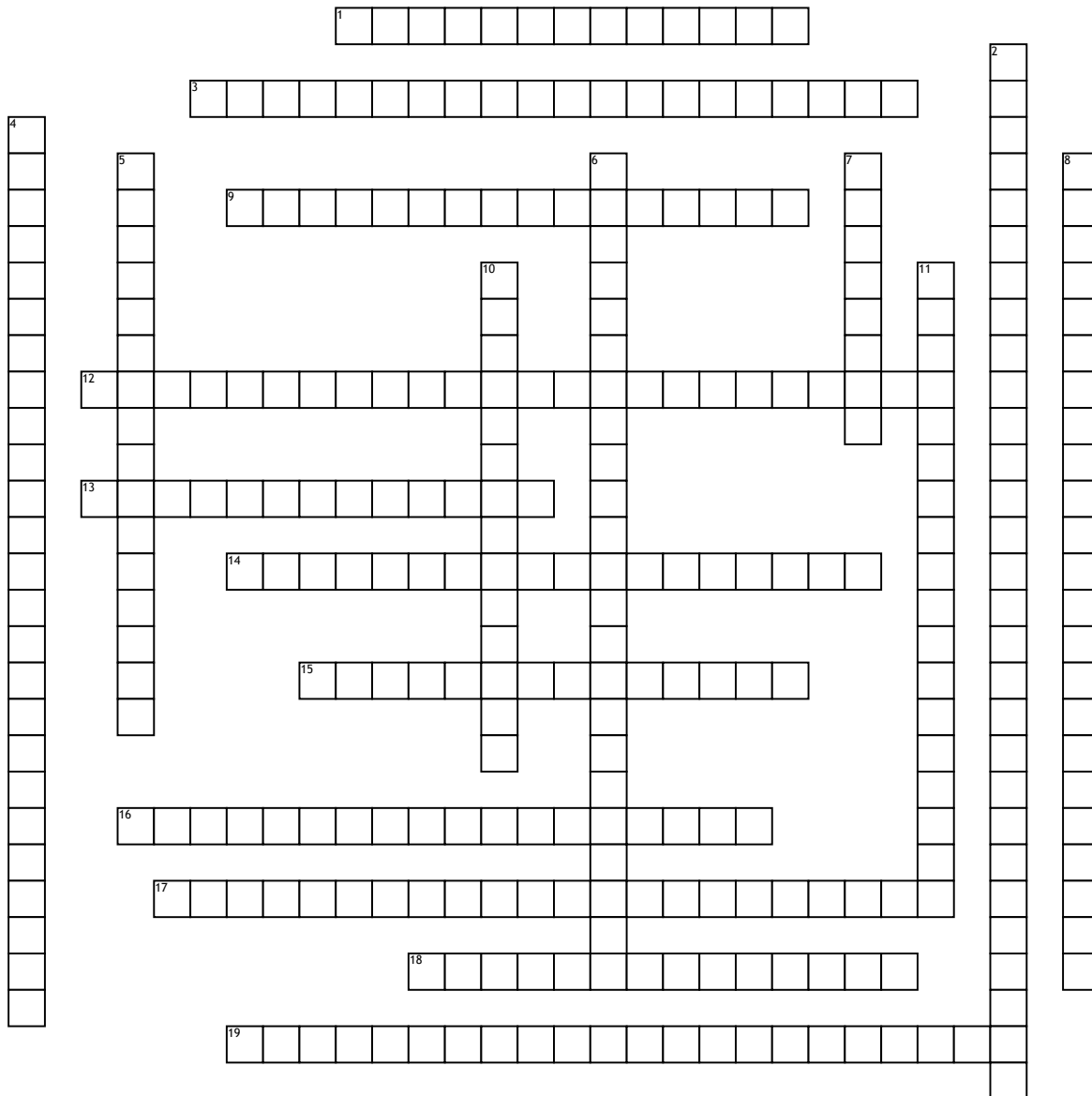

1. Treaty Between England and the Colonies, formally ended the American Revolutionary war
3. Act forcing colonists to house and supply British forces in the colonies
9. American victory over British troops in 1777 that was a turning point in American Revolution.
12. Applied only to Massachusetts to punish them for Boston Tea Party
13. A group of colonists who formed a secret society to oppose British policies at the time of the American Revolution
14. A proclamation from British government which forbade British colonists from settling west of the Appalachian Mountains, required any settlers living west of the mountains to move back east.

15. Rebellion led by Daniel Shays of farmers in western Massachusetts in 1786-1787, highlighted the need for strong national government.
16. (1754-1763) War fought in the colonies between the English and the French for possession of the Ohio Valley area. The English won.
17. law that established a procedure for admission of new states to Union
18. The first bloodshed of the American Revolution, as British guards at Boston opened fire on a crowd
19. Approved the creation of a Continental Army and the Declaration of Independence.

2. Plan to have a popularly elected House based on state population and a state-selected Senate, with two members for each state

4. (4 July 1776) asserting the independence of the colonies from Great Britain
5. Last major battle of the Revolutionary War. Cornwallis and his troops were trapped in Chesapeake Bay by French fleet. He surrendered October 19, 1781.
6. 1st Constitution of the U.S. 1781-1788
7. 1765; law that taxed printed goods
8. Pamphlet published in 1776 that persuaded American Colonists to support independence.
10. 1773 protest against British taxes in Boston, colonists disguised as Mohawks dumped valuable tea into Boston Harbor
11. 3/5 of slaves count towards states' population for taxation and representation in House of Representatives
