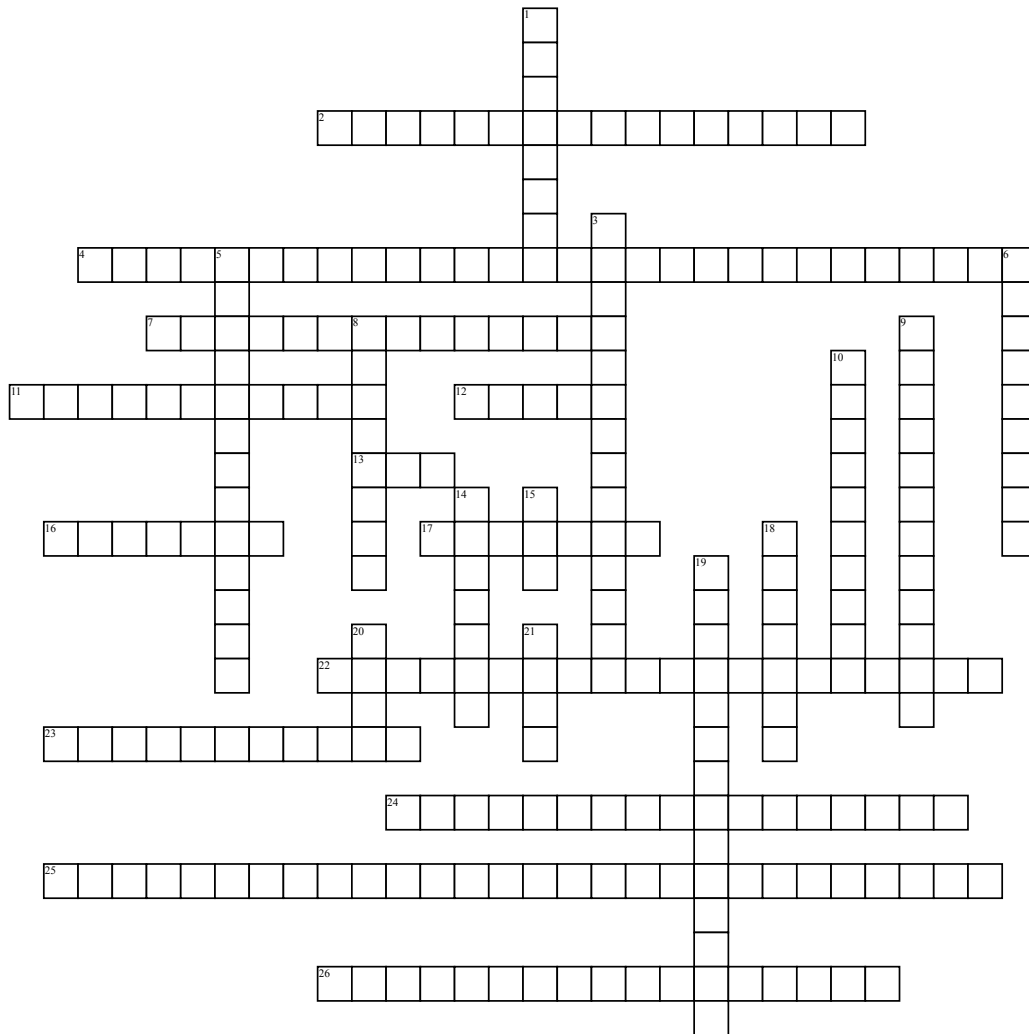

2. Agreement signed by Israel in Egypt in 1978 that set the formal terms for peace in the Middle East.

The first agreements, known as SALT I and SALT II, were signed by the United States and the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics in 1972 and 1979, respectively, and were intended to restrain the arms race in strategic (long-range or intercontinental) ballistic missiles armed with nuclear weapons.  
 13. Federal agency created in 1970 to oversee environmental monitoring and cleanup programs.

 17. state of political hostility between countries characterized by threats, propaganda, and other measures short of open warfare.  
 22. U.S. military campaign to force Iraqi forces out of Kuwait.  
 23. the economic policies of former US president Ronald Reagan, associated especially with the reduction of taxes and promotion of unrestricted free-market activity.

24. The Iran hostage crisis was a diplomatic standoff between the United States and Iran. Fifty-two American diplomats and citizens were held hostage for 444 days.  
 25. An act that required employers to provide access to their facilities for qualified employees with disabilities.  
 26. A set of policies to open opportunities to business and education for members of minority groups and women by allowing race and sex to be factors included in decisions to hire, award contracts, or admit students to higher education programs.
