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| 1. Pact that renounced the use of force to achieve national ends; ineffective as it permitted defensive wars and failed to provide punishment for violators of agreement | A. Rural Electrification Admin. |
| 2. A cycle of payments flowing from US to Germany and from Germany to the Allies; US banks would lend Germany sums to rebuild economy and pay Britain and France so they could pay war debts to US | B. Neutrality Act of 1937 |
| 3. Set tax increases ranging from 31-49% on foreign imports; European countries raised their tariffs in retaliation | C. Work Progress Administration |
| 4. Suspension on payment of international debt; Germany and Britain agreed but France balked | D. Neutrality Act of 1936 |
| 5. Spent billions of dollars from 1935-1940 to provide people with jobs constructing new bridges, roads, airports, and public buildings | E. Neutrality Act of 1935 |
| 6. Provided loans to sharecroppers, tenants, and small farmers; established federal camps where migrant workers could find decent housing | F. Wagner Act |
| 7. Guaranteed a worker's right to join a union and a union's right to bargain collectively; outlawed business practices that were unfair to labor | G. Debt Moratorium |
| 8. Provided loans for electrical cooperatives to supply power in rural areas | H. Resettlement Administration |
| 9. President prohibit all arms shipments and forbid US citizens to travel on the ships of belligerent nations | I. Kellogg-Briand Pact |
| 10. Forbade extension of loans and credits to belligerents | J. Dawes Plan |
| 11. Forbade shipment of arms to the opposing side in the civil war in Spain | K. Hawley-Smoot Tariff |
