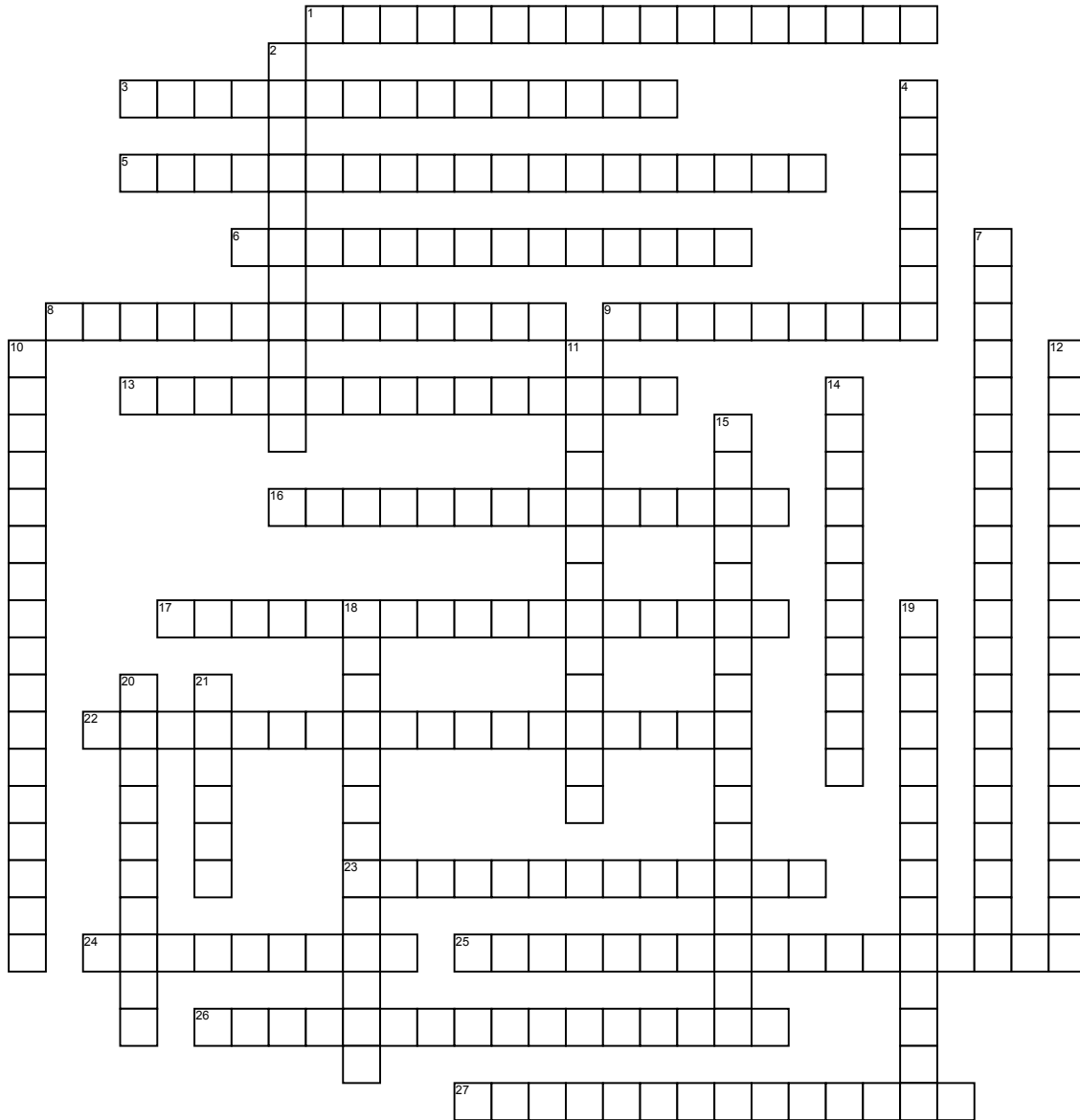

- 3. Powers held jointly by the national and state governments
- 5. Special joint committee appointed to reconcile differences when bills are passed
- 6. System in which states and national governments remain supreme within their own sphere
- 8. Passage by Congress specifying the amount of authorized funds that will be used in an agency's use
- 9. One who achieves unexpected support and success as a political candidate
- 13. Government spending in excess of revenue
- 16. Section of Constitution in which Congress is given the power to regulate trade

- 2. Large organization that is structured hierarchically to carry out specific functions

- 11. Intraparty in which the voters select the candidates who will run on a party's ticket
- 12. Major principal of the American system of government whereby each branch of government can check the actions of the others
- 14. Federal Programs that provides funds to state and local governments for functional agencies

- 18. Grants Congress the power to do whatever is necessary to execute its delegated powers
- 19. Personal freedoms that are protected for all
- 20. Transfer of powers from a national or federal government to a state or local government
