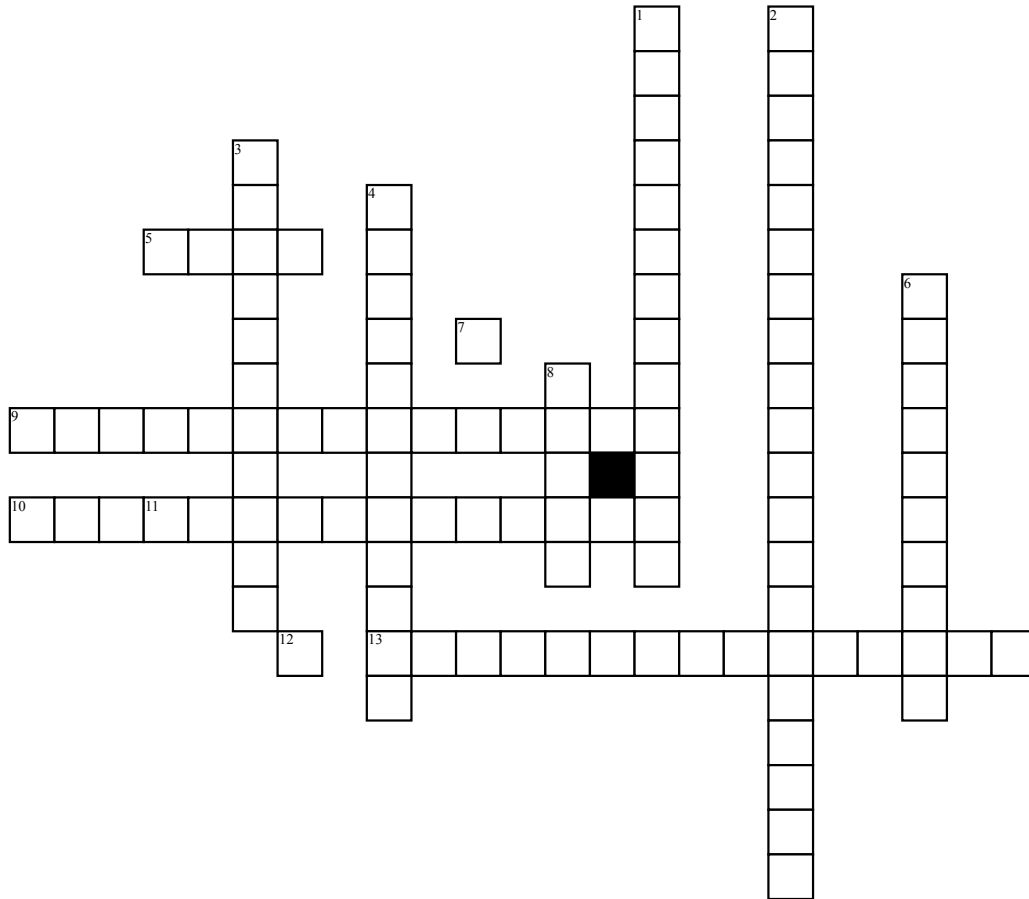

## Across

- 5.** assumed to be the center of personality, organizer of our thoughts, and feelings  
**7.** Freud's theory of personality that attributes thoughts and actions to the relationships between the conscious mind and the unconscious mind  
**9.** extent to which perceive control over their environment rather than feelings  
**10.** a readiness to perceive oneself favorably

- 12.** personality test designed to let a person respond to ambiguous stimuli, presumably revealing hidden emotions and internal conflicts projected by the person  
**13.** the tendency to think that more people notice something about you than they do

- 1.** giving priority to one's own goal over group goals  
**2.** tests that attempt to characterize the personality of an individual by objective scoring of replies to a large number of questions concerning his or her own behavior
