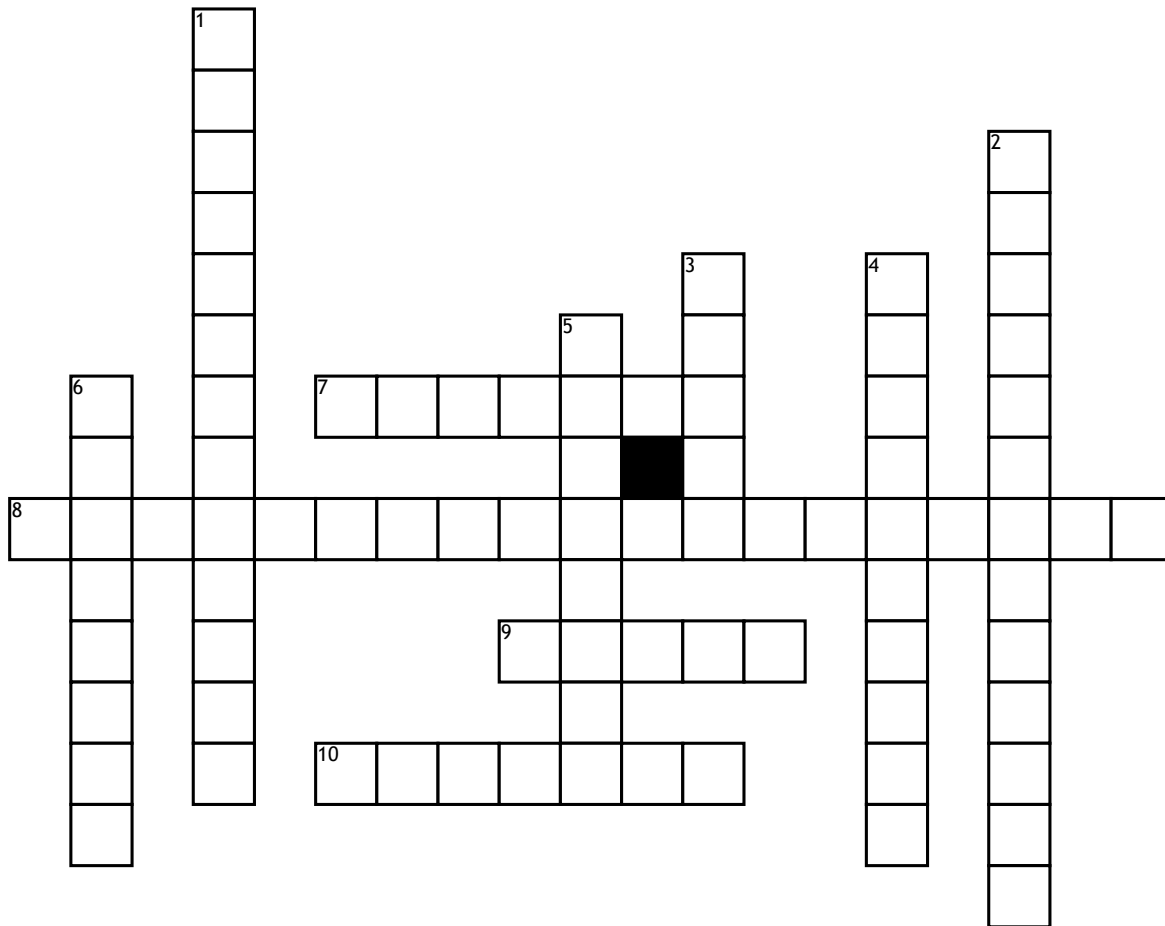


A Kid's Life in Colonial St. Augustine
