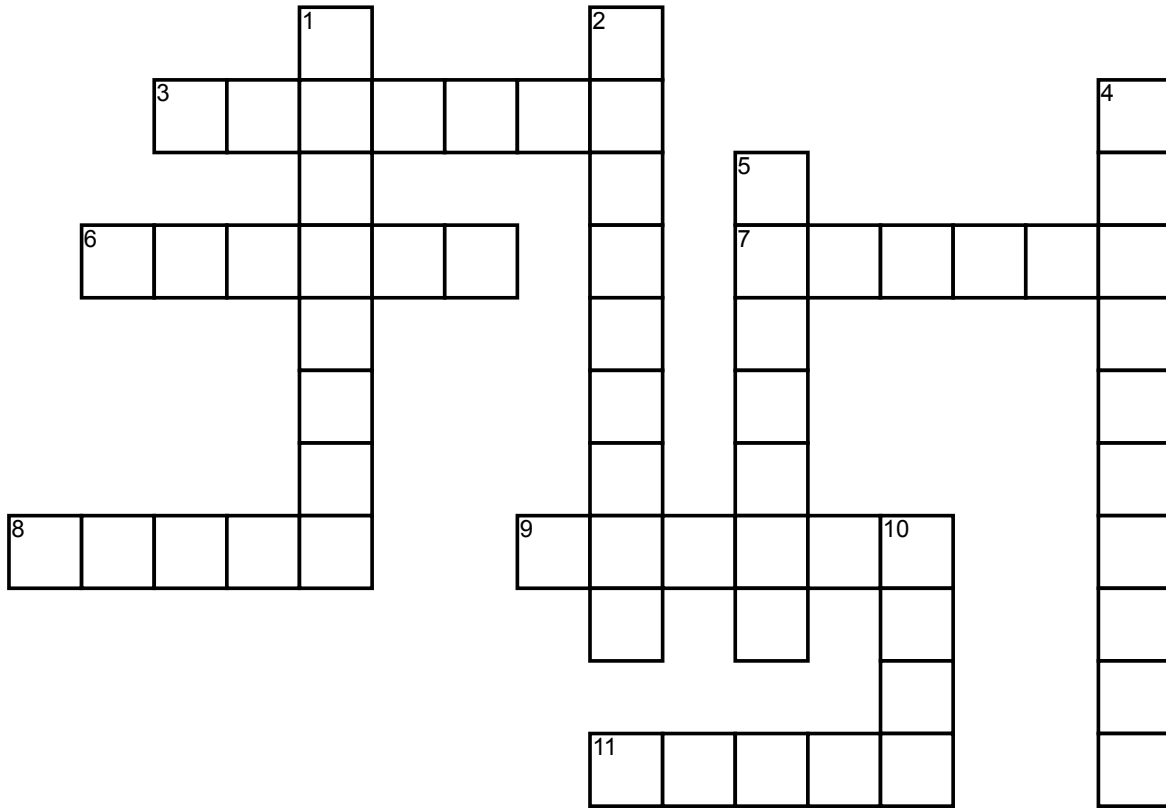


A Long Walk To Water
