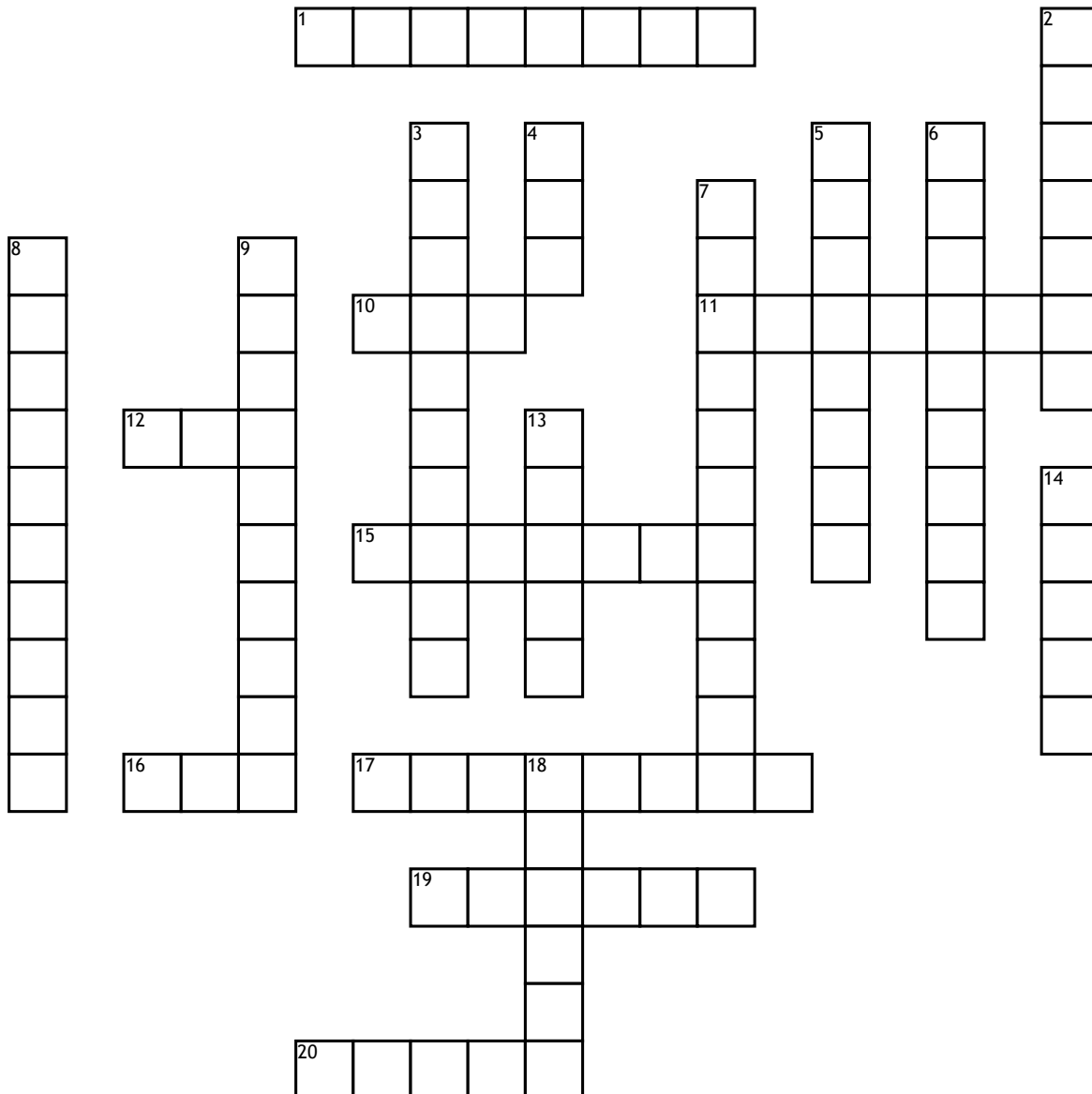


# A Long Way Gone Crossword
