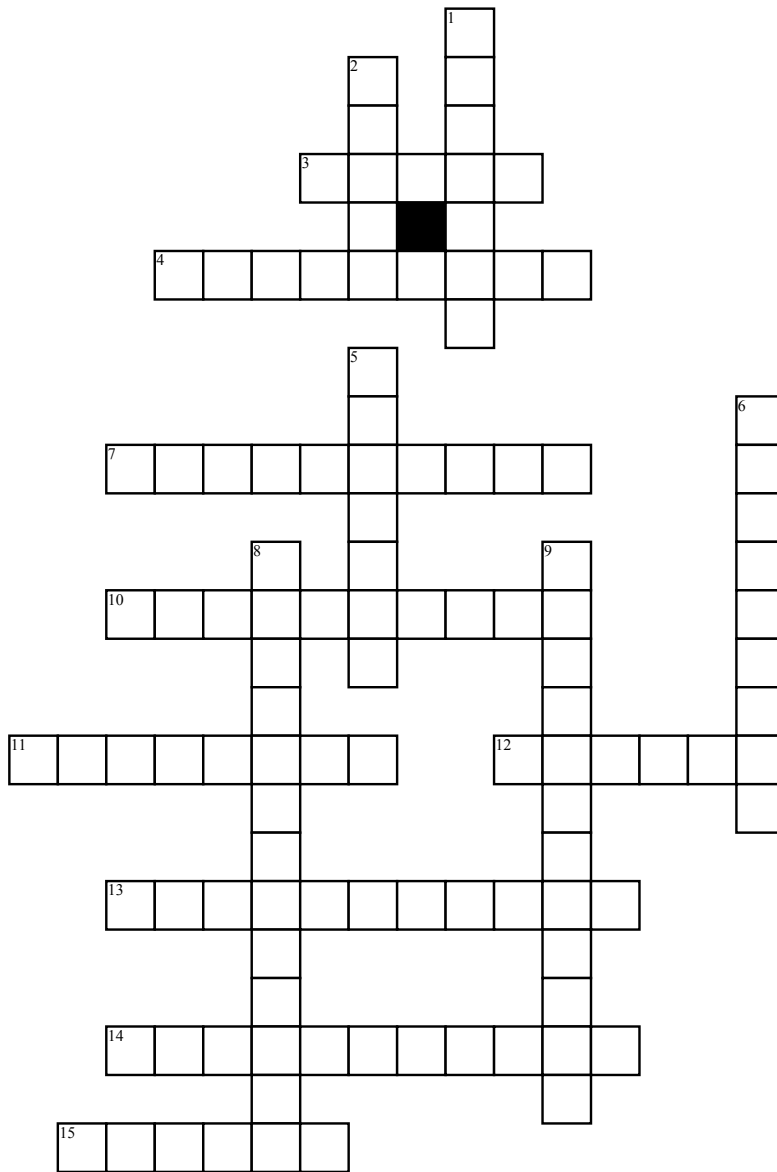


# A Red Herring Without Mustard
