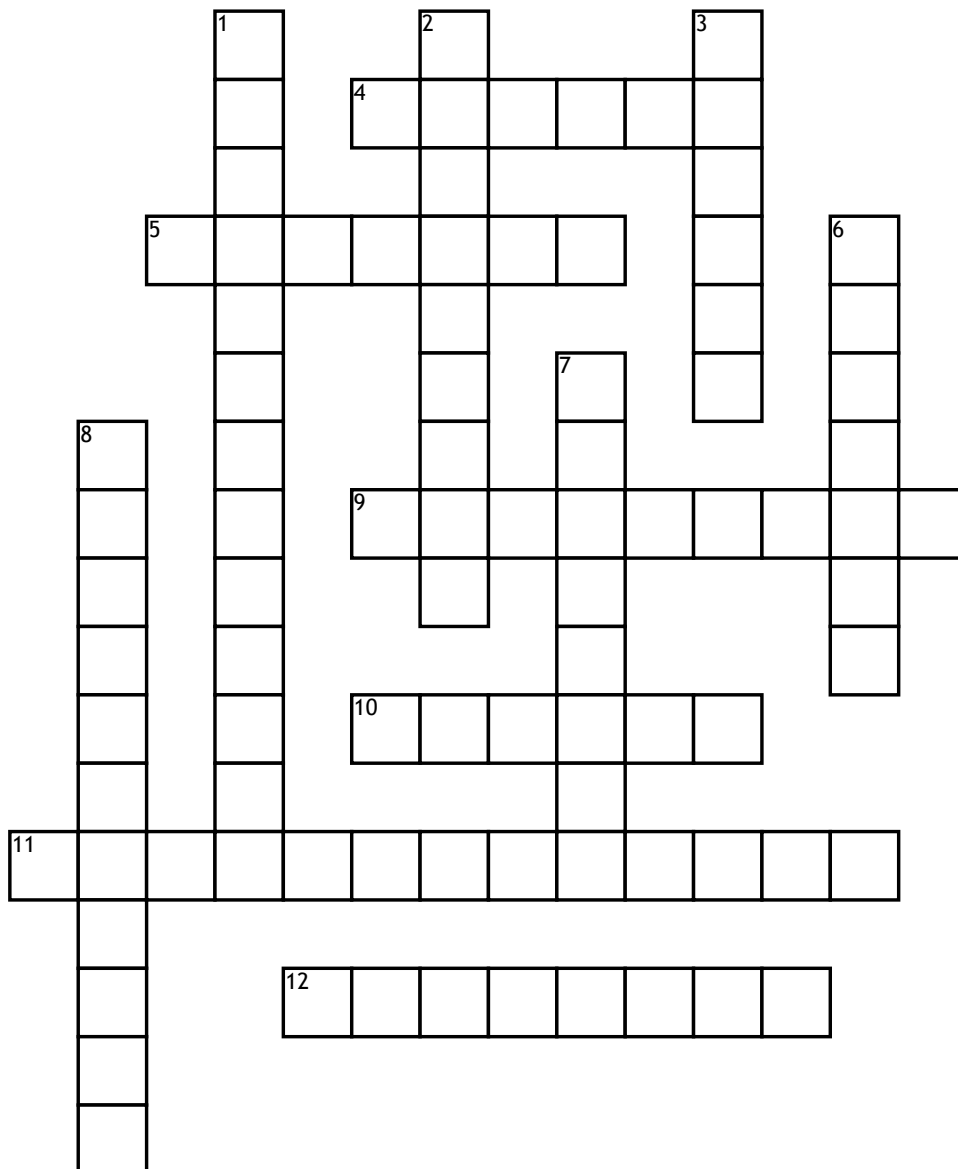


A 'welcome back' retrieval crossword!
