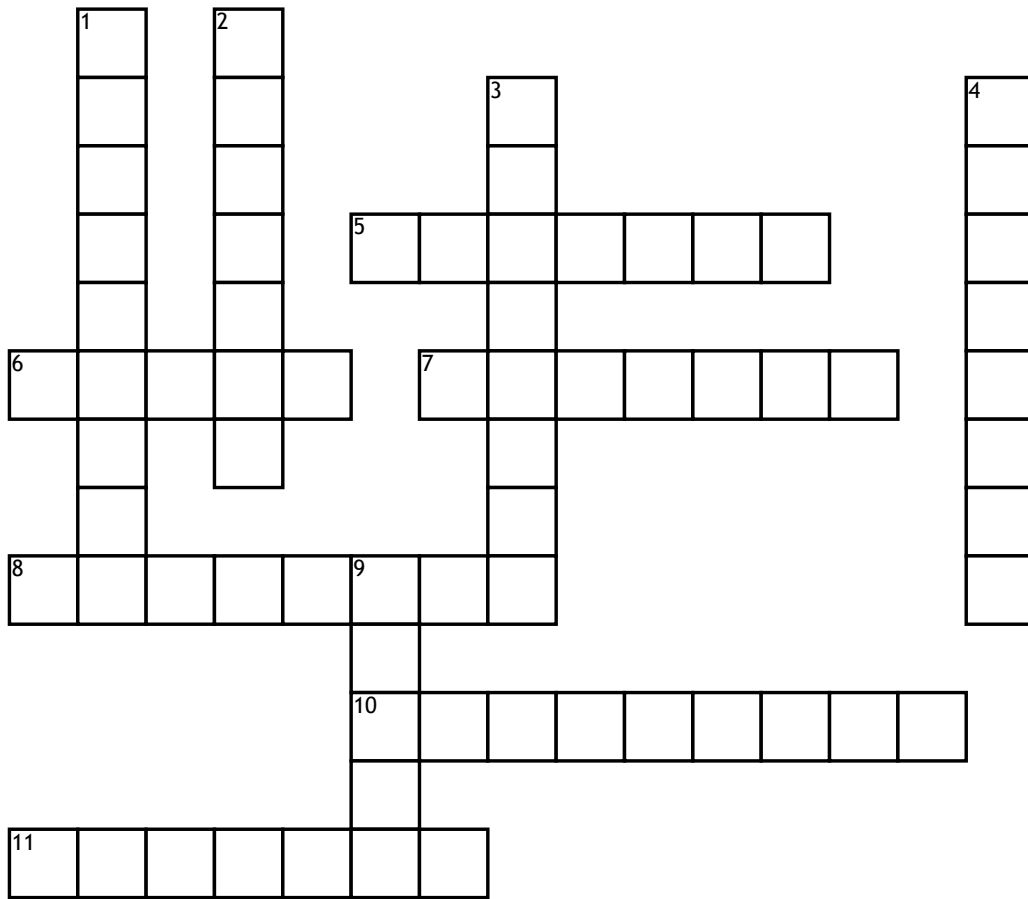


Academic Power Words

- 2. to make a guess about what might happen next
- 3. to decide the value or worth after study
- 4. to share all of the ways that things are different
- 9. to read between the lines, to make decisions based on information that may not be stated outright
