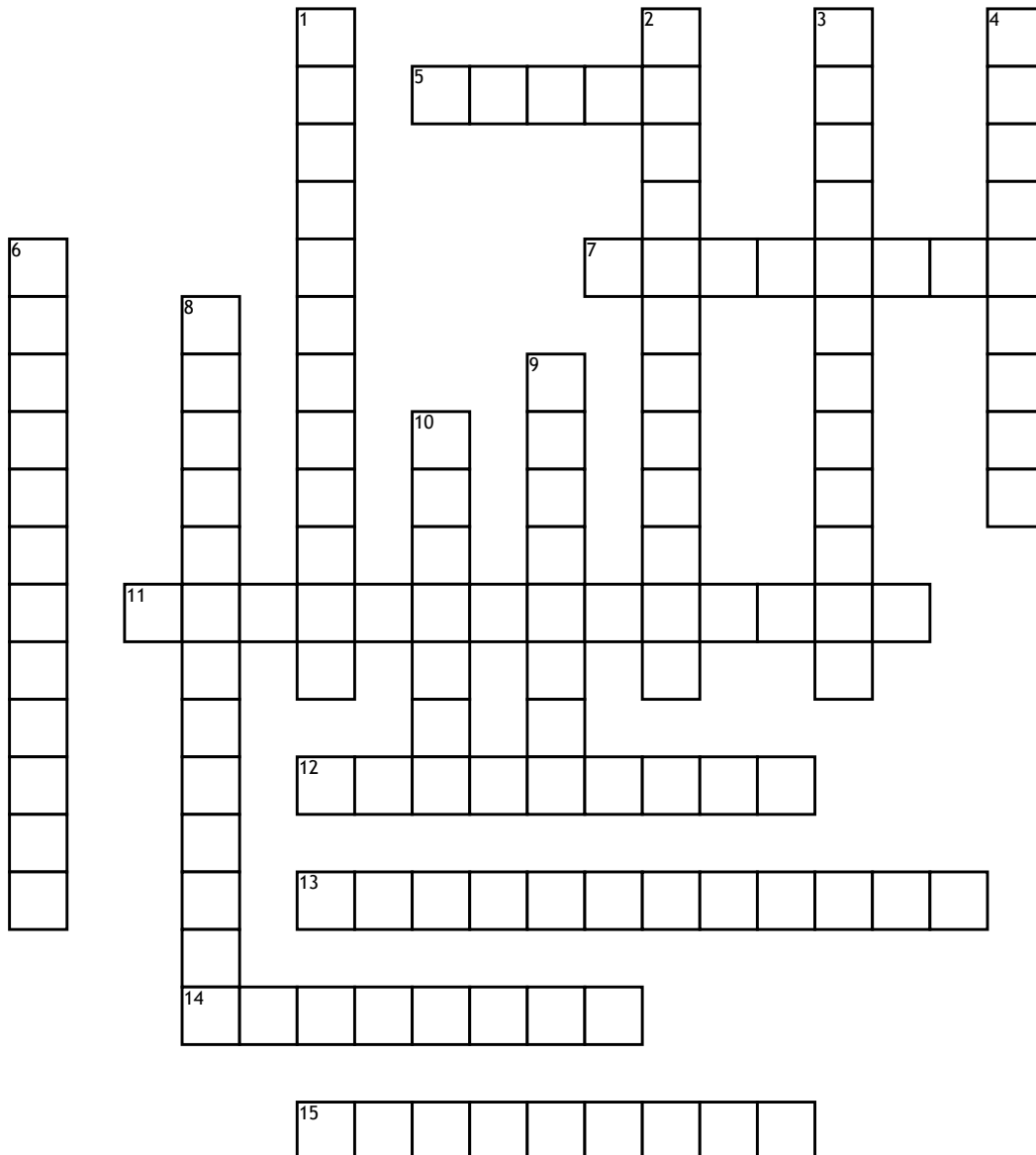


Achondroplasia Crossword
