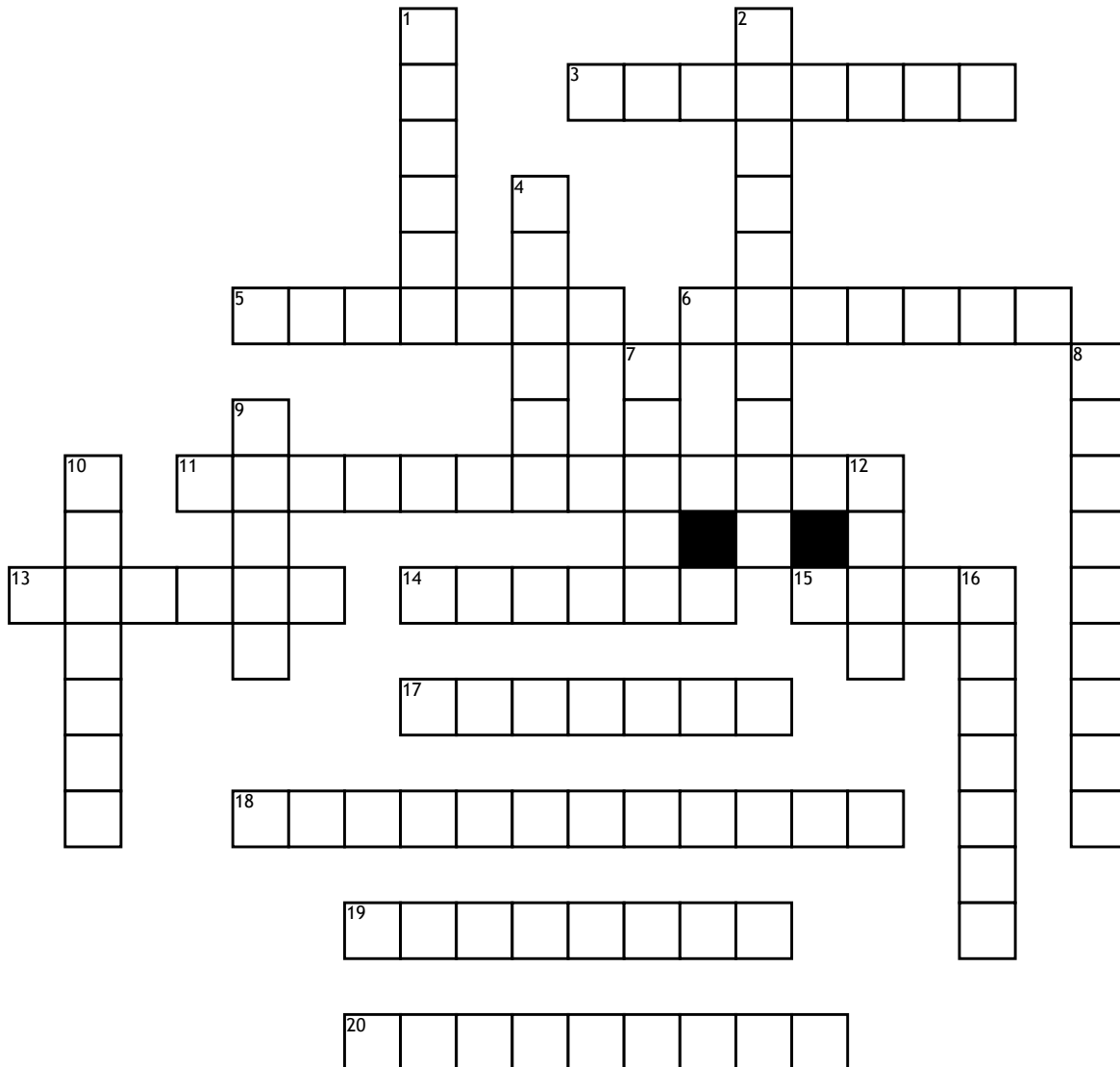


Acts 1 Crossword
