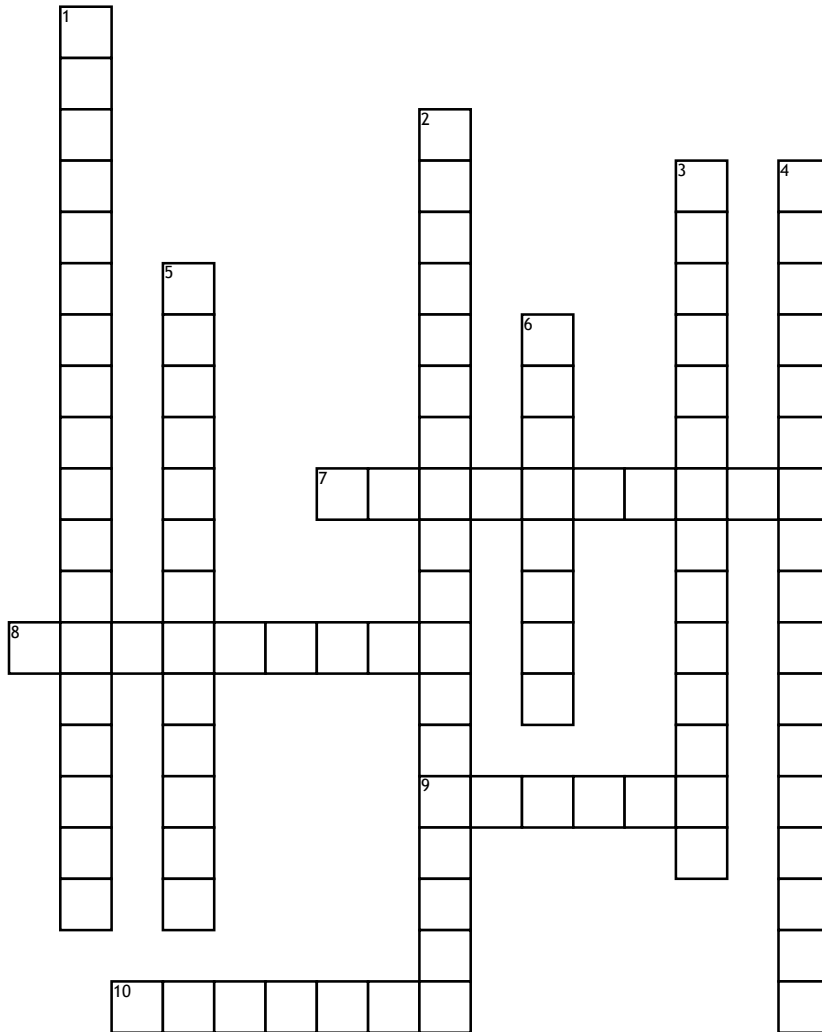


# Adult Court Process
