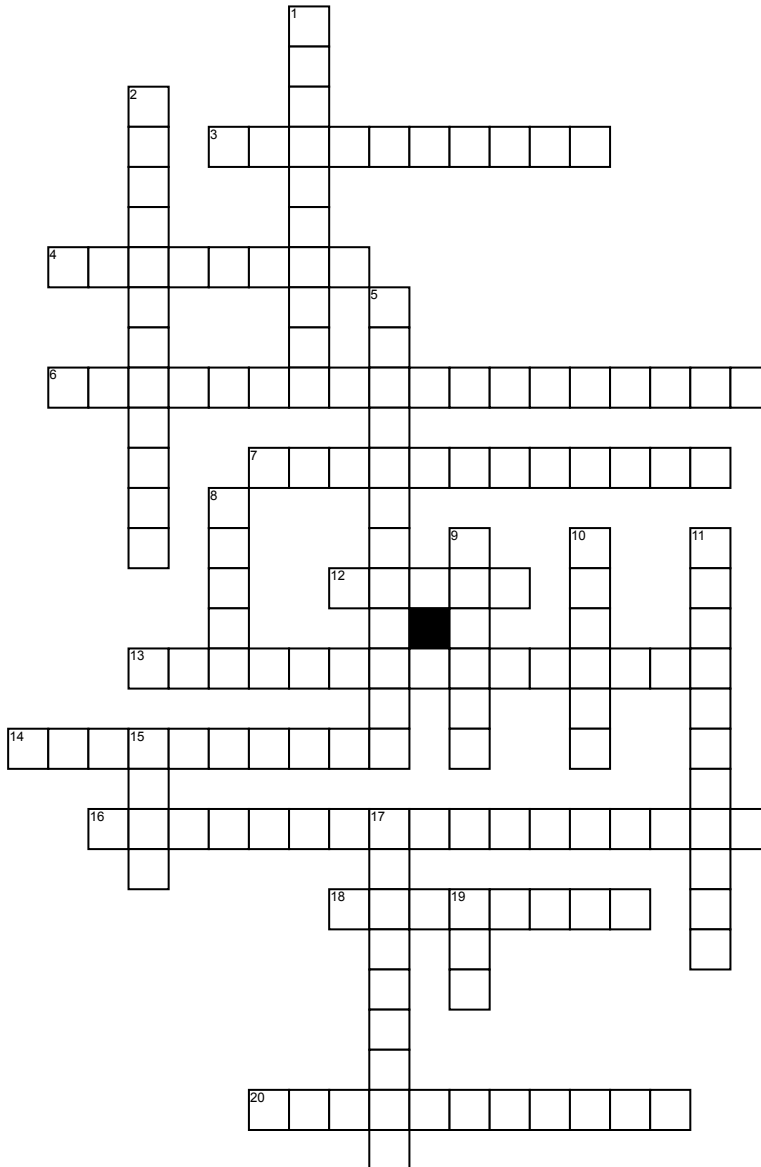


Africa Crossword Puzzle
