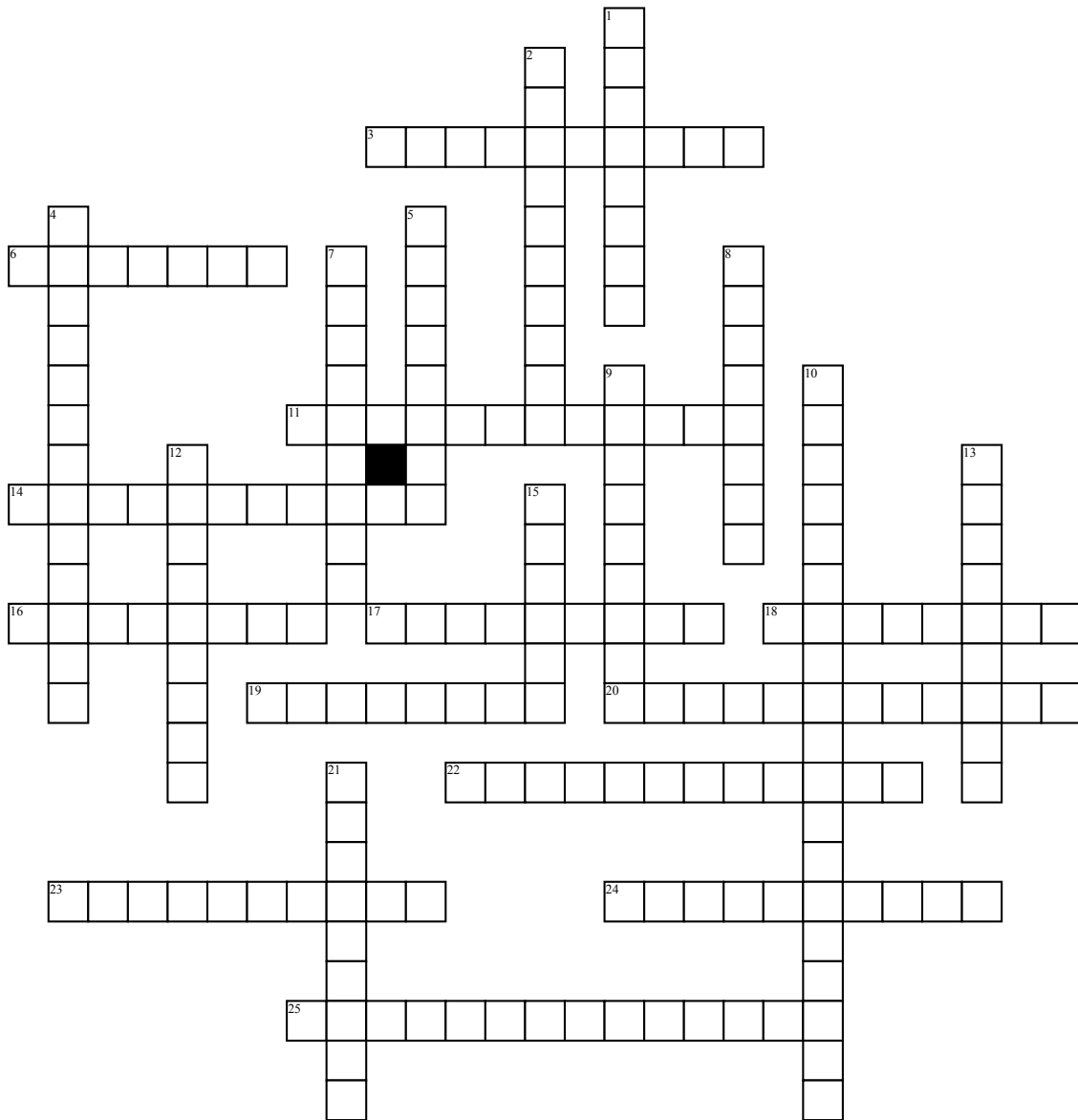

- 3. fear and hatred of strangers or foreigners or of anything that is strange or foreign
- 6. intolerance toward those who hold different opinions from oneself
- 11. reflecting a tendency to interpret the world in terms of European values and experiences
- 14. the status of belonging to a particular nation
- 16. a typical example or pattern of something; a model
- 17. a particular ethnic affiliation or group
- 18. the movement, migration, or scattering of a people away from an established or ancestral homeland
- 19. extreme patriotism, especially in the form of aggressive or warlike foreign policy.
- 20. the theory of knowledge, especially with regard to its methods, validity, and scope
- 22. emphasizing or promoting emphasis on African culture and the contributions of Africans to the development of Western civilization

- 23. an economic and political system in which a country's trade and industry are controlled by private owners for profit, rather than by the state
- 24. a widely held but fixed and oversimplified image or idea of a particular type of person or thing
- 25. the unjust or prejudicial treatment of different categories of people or things, especially on the grounds of race, age, or sex

- 2. unjust or cruel exercise of authority or power
- 4. the forced voyage of enslaved Africans across the Atlantic Ocean to the Americas
- 5. the study of the nature of value and valuation, and of the kinds of things that are valuable.
- 7. a political theory derived from Karl Marx, advocating class war and leading to a society in which all property is publicly owned and each person works and is paid according to their abilities and needs

- 8. leadership or dominance, especially by one country or social group over others
- 9. preconceived judgment or opinion formed without just grounds or before sufficient knowledge
- 10. the state of having inconsistent thoughts, beliefs, or attitudes, especially as relating to behavioral decisions and attitude change
- 12. a comprehensive conception or apprehension of the world especially from a specific standpoint
- 13. a branch of astronomy that deals with the origin, structure, and space-time relationships of the universe a theory dealing with these matters
- 15. a belief that race is the primary determinant of human traits and capacities and that racial differences produce an inherent superiority of a particular race
- 21. a political and economic theory of social organization which advocates that the means of production, distribution, and exchange should be owned or regulated by the community as a whole
