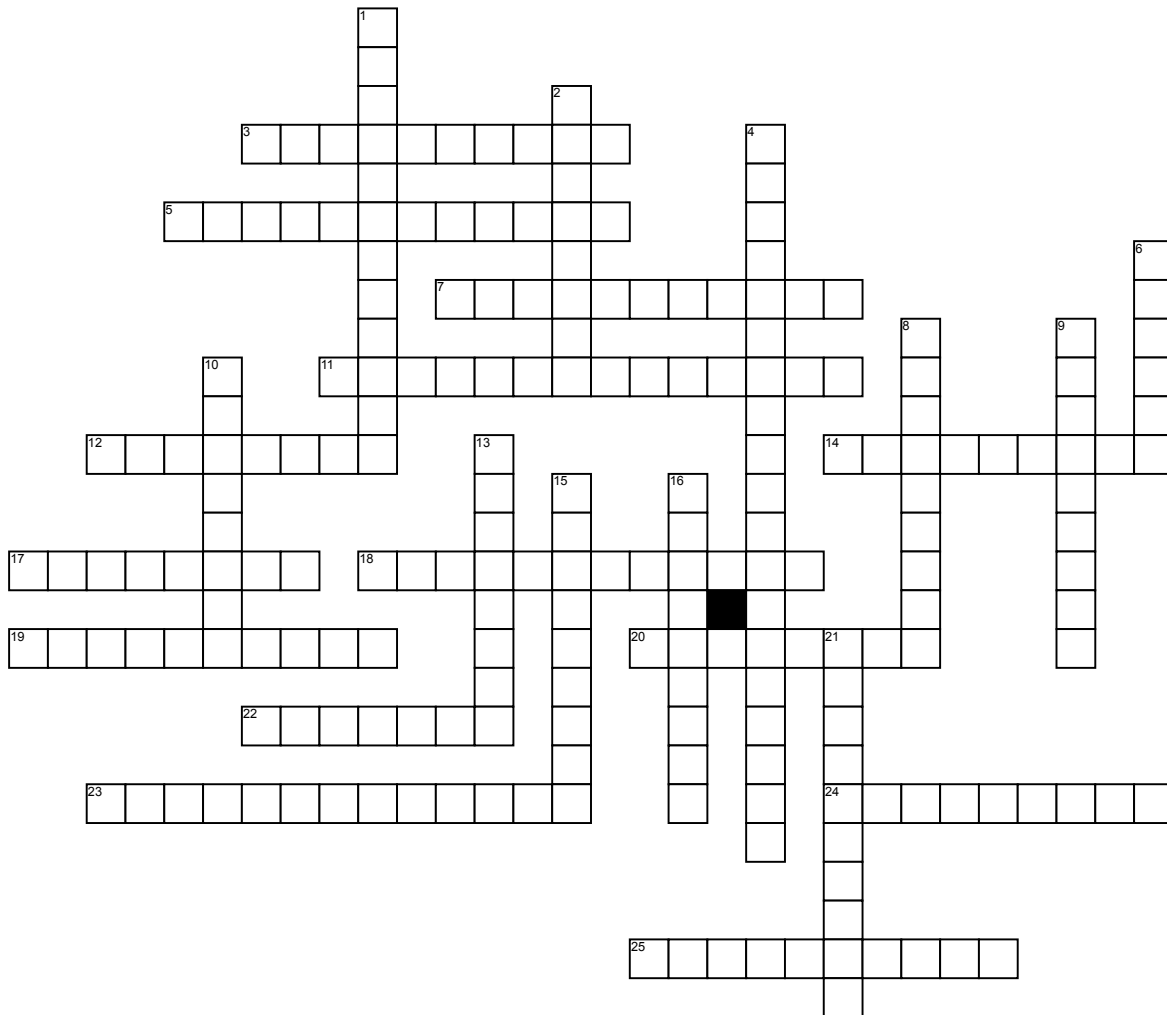


Africana studies Unit Glossary Crossword Puzzle
