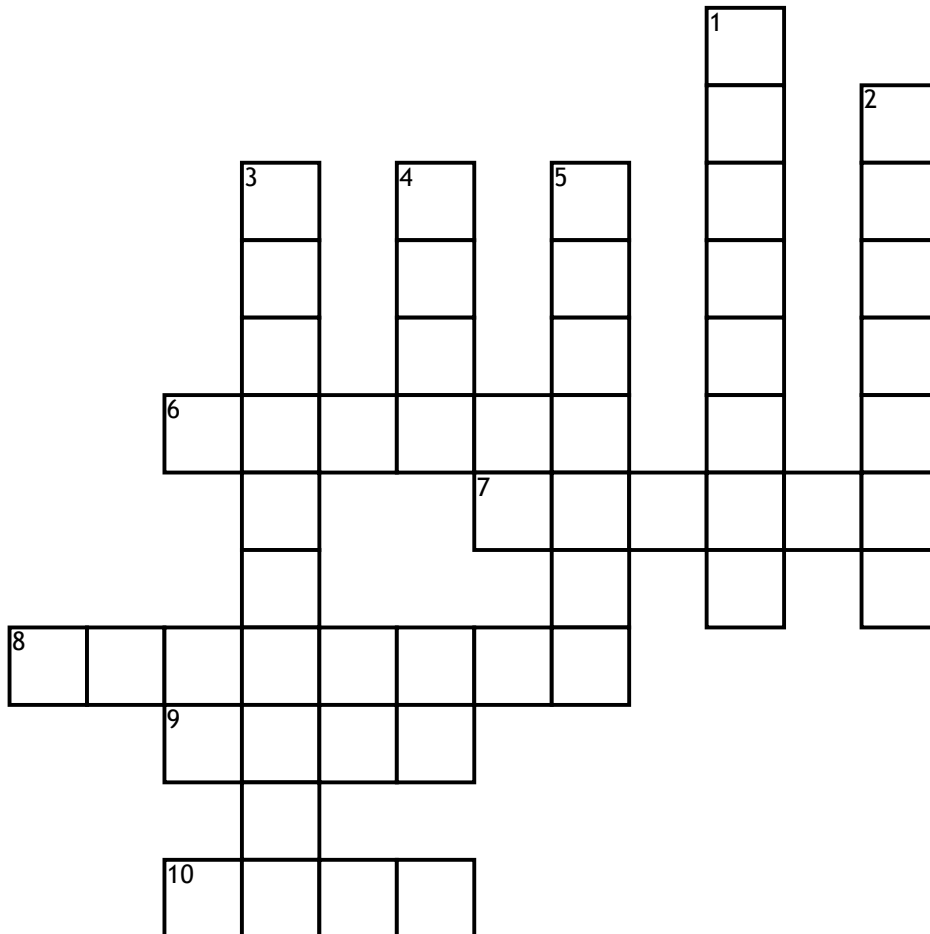


Alaskan Mining Towns
