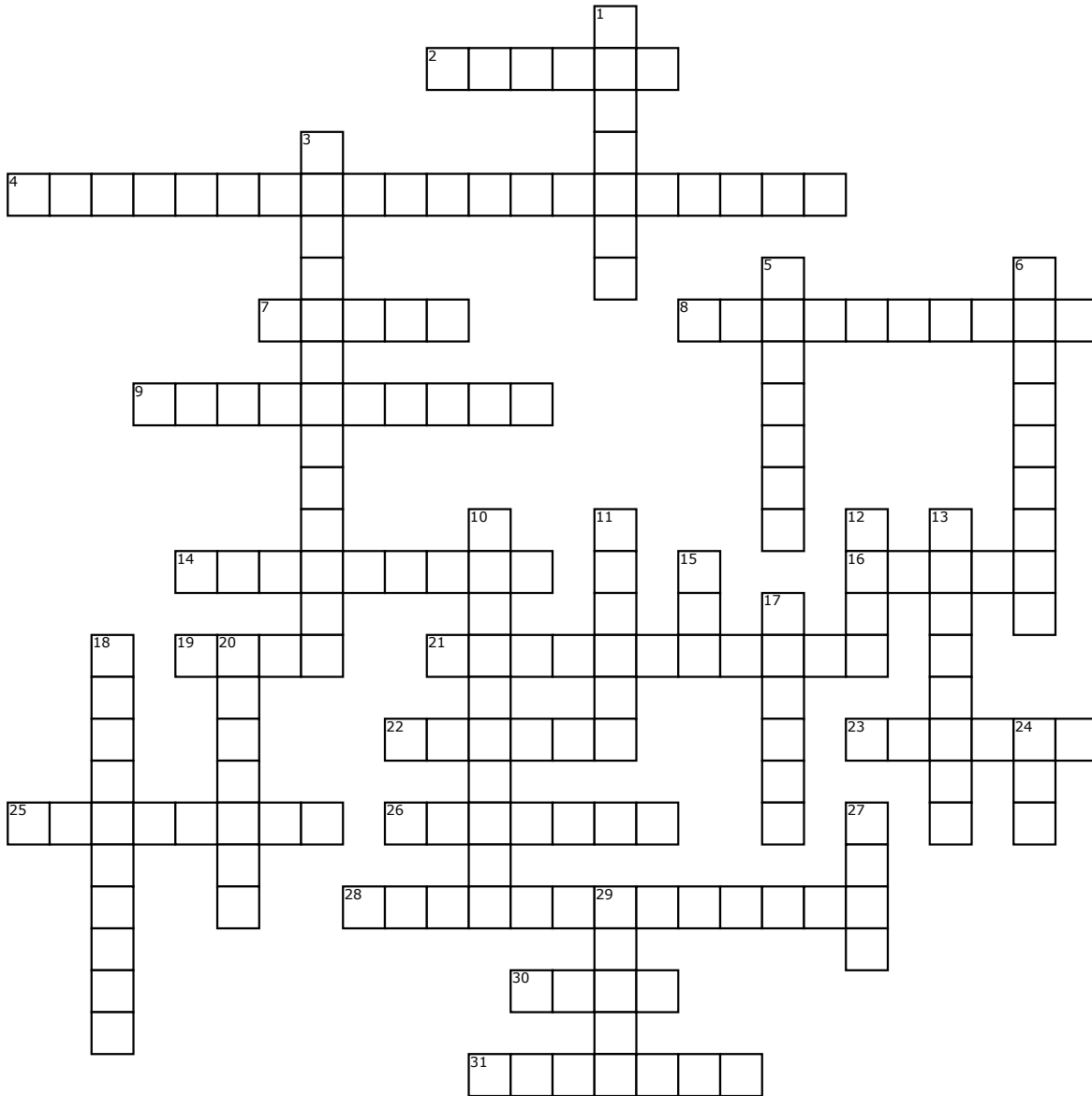


All Animals' crossword puzzle
