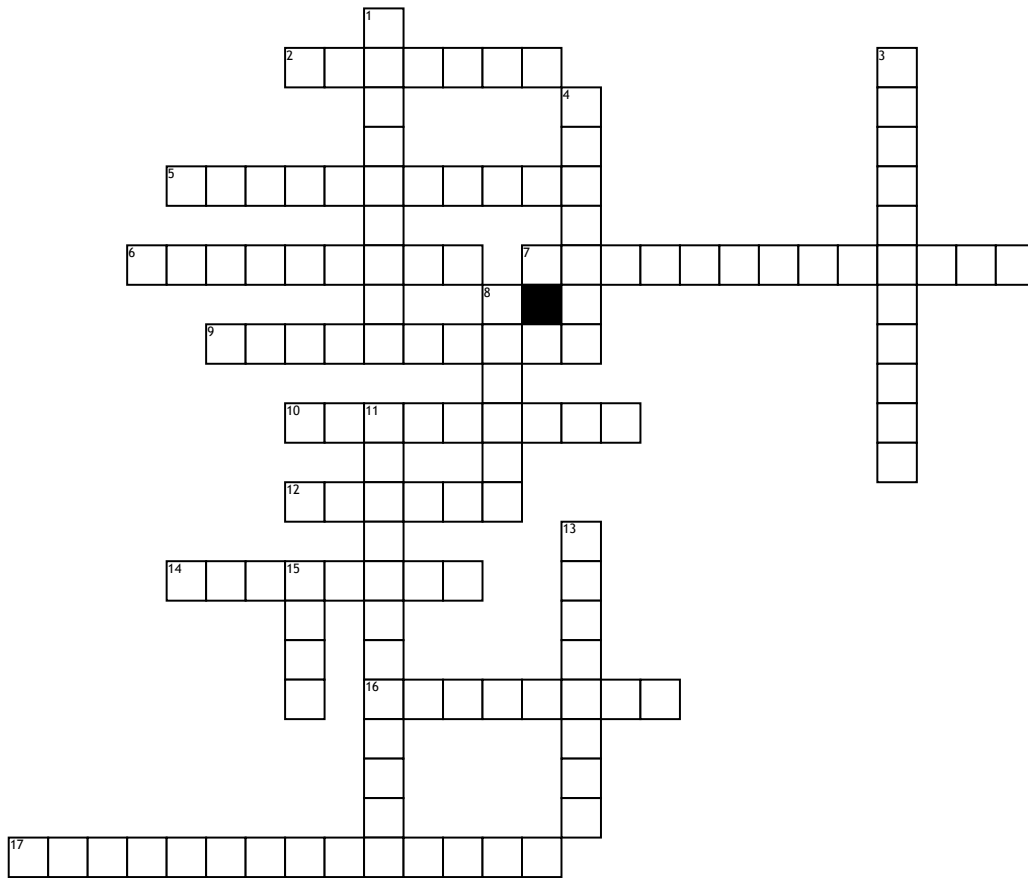


Ambulation transfer ROM



Across

2. progressive decline of body part or tissue
 5. deformity that results from abnormal shortening of muscle tissue, making the muscle highly resistant to stretching
 6. Movement away from midline of the body
 7. circular movement of a limb or the eye
 9. movement of the body part so that its front or ventral surface faces upward
 10. movement toward the midline of the body

12. directed toward or situated on the back surface
 14. sitting on the side of the bed with the legs suspended freely from the knees
 16. turning of the body part away from the body's midline
 17. movement of the body part beyond its usual resting and extended position

Down

1. movement of a body part so that its front or ventral surface face downward
 3. increase in the volume of a tissue or organ produced entirely by enlargement of existing cells

4. movement that decreases the angle between two adjoining bones, bending of limb
 8. farthest from origin of part
 11. upward bending of the toes and the foot
 13. nearest to the origin of the part
 15. the pattern of how a person ambulates
