17. This plan proposed a unicameral Congress in which each state has equal representation.

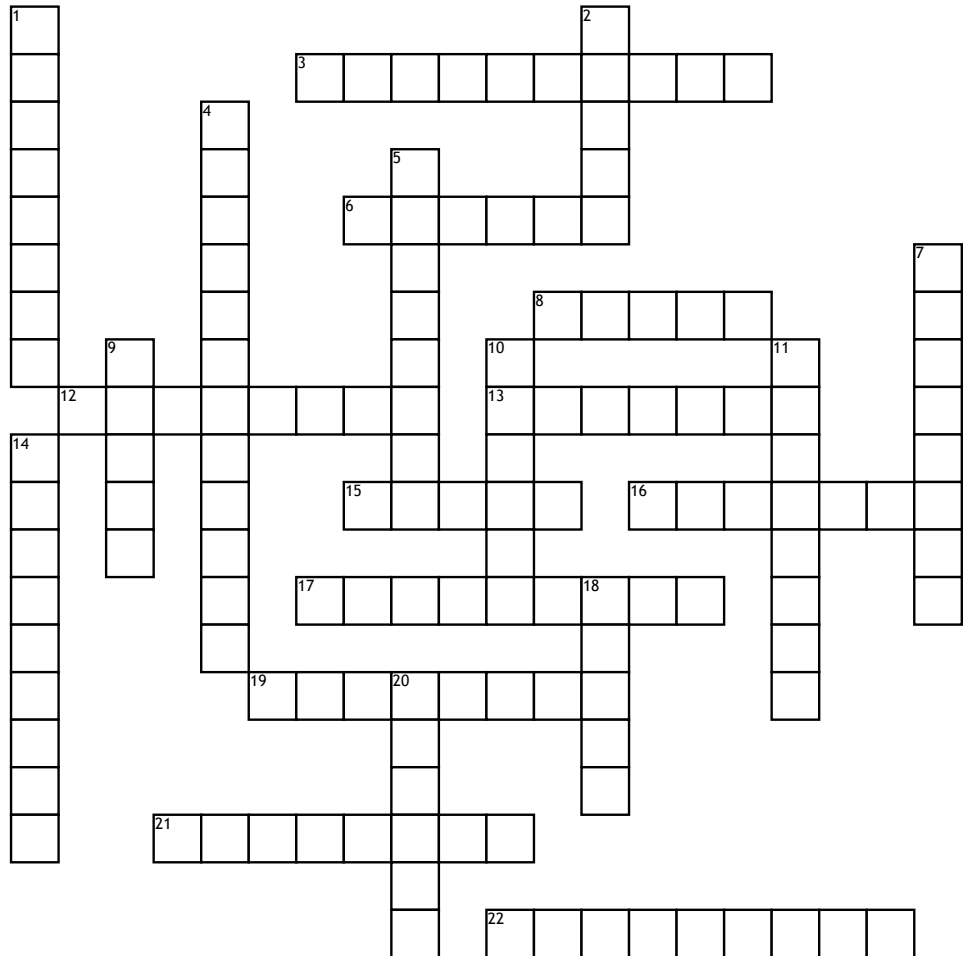
19. Occurring on October 17, 1777, this decisive battle gave victory to the Patriots in upstate New York. This helped solidify French support for the Patriots' fight for independence.
