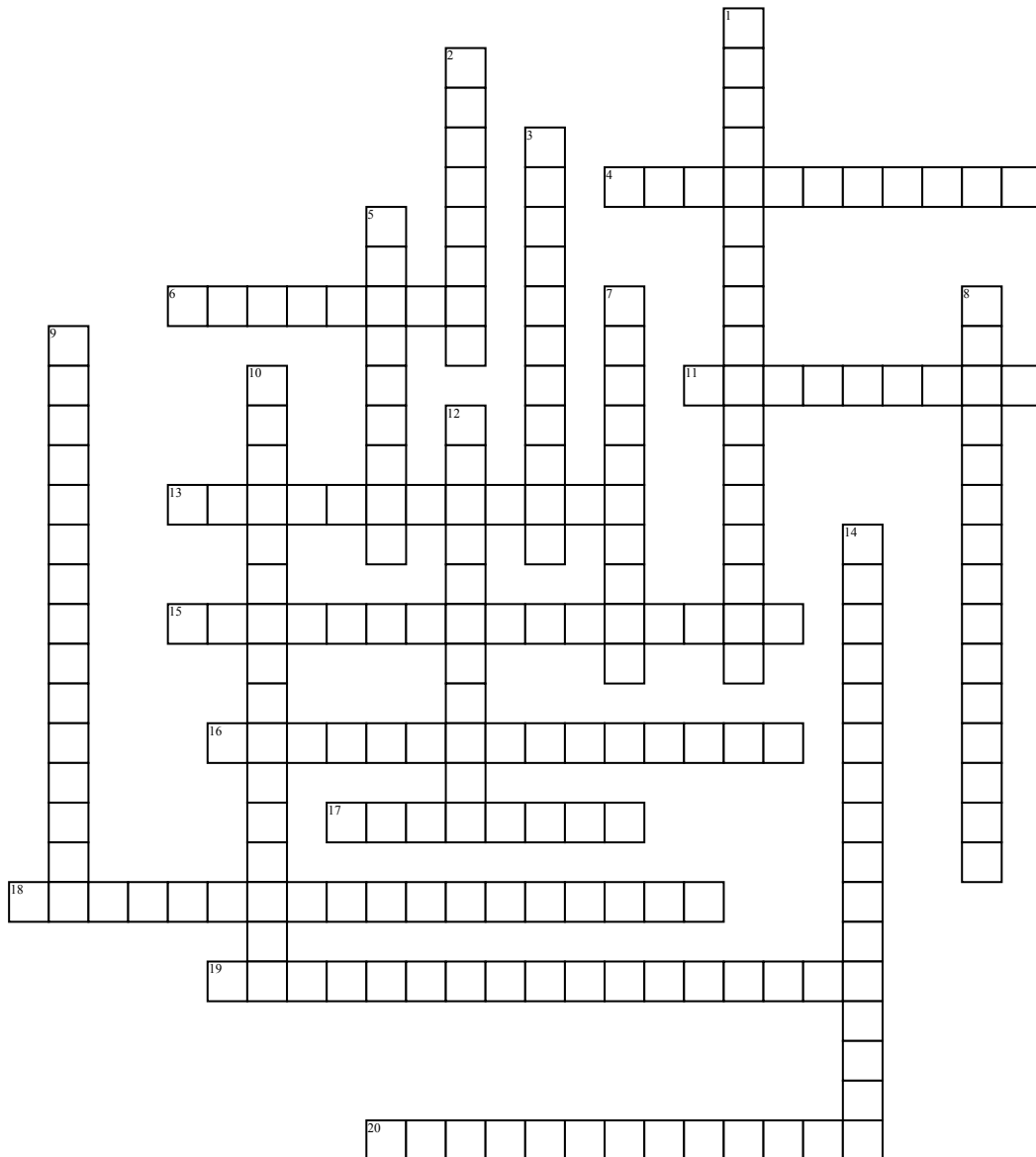


American Revolution

- 4. Dec 19, 1777 – Jun 19, 1778 winter camp after Brandywine, lots of disease and suffering during the winter, but also valuable training.
- 6. remains loyal to the established ruler or government, especially in the face of a revolt.
- 11. Delivered cannons from Fort Ticonderoga to Boston for GW.
- 13. Said "Give me liberty, or give me death!"
- 15. Served as a general and commander-in-chief of the colonial armies during the American Revolutionary War.
- 16. surprise Hessians, famous crossing of the Delaware December 26, 1776.

- 17. October 19, 1781 GW and French surround Cornwallis, Cornwallis surrenders, ending war. Hoorryyyy!!!
- 18. British invasion August 27, 1776, GW reads Declaration to inspire the troops, army barely avoids annihilation/capture.
- 19. ha ha Cornwallis fell for the old campfire trick January 3, 1777.
- 20. A founding father of the U.S, was a solicitor and politician from Philadelphia.
