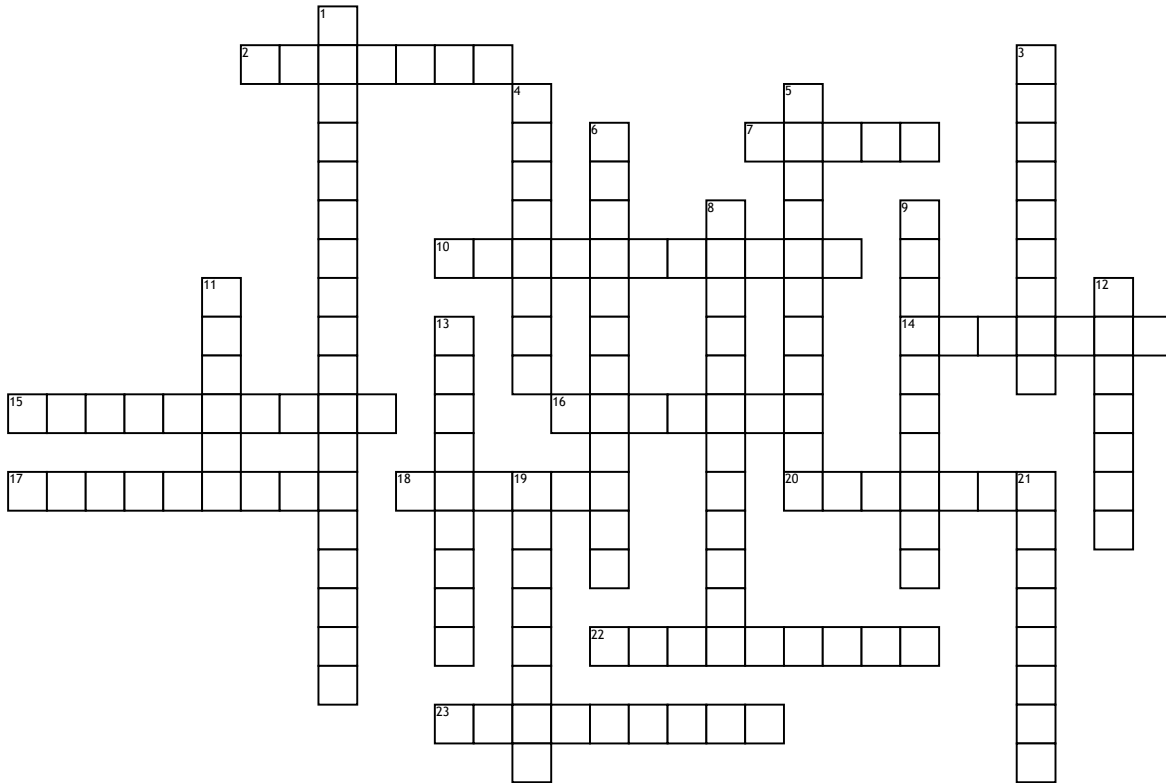

- 7. Strongest and longest bone in the human body
- 10. Allow only gliding or sliding movements
- 14. Type of muscle found only in the heart
- 15. Group of muscles four muscles located in the anterior thigh
- 16. Triangular shaped bone posterior to the ribs and clavicle
- 17. Bundles of connective tissue that connect bone to bone

- 18. Closer to the middle/inside of the body

- 20. Long flat bone located in the centre of the chest
- 22. Largest chest muscle
- 23. Contraction in which no movement takes place

- 1. Standard starting point for viewing the body
- 3. Attaches the shoulder blade and the ribcage
- 4. What part of the spine does this relate to: hold the rib cage and protect the heart and lungs
- 5. Long bones within the foot

- 6. Bones of the limbs

- 8. Held together by only a ligament

- 9. Contraction in which the muscle decreases in length (shortens)

- 11. Laying flat facing upwards
- 12. 8 small bones that make up the wrist

- 13. Towards the back of the body
- 19. Below / towards the bottom of the body
