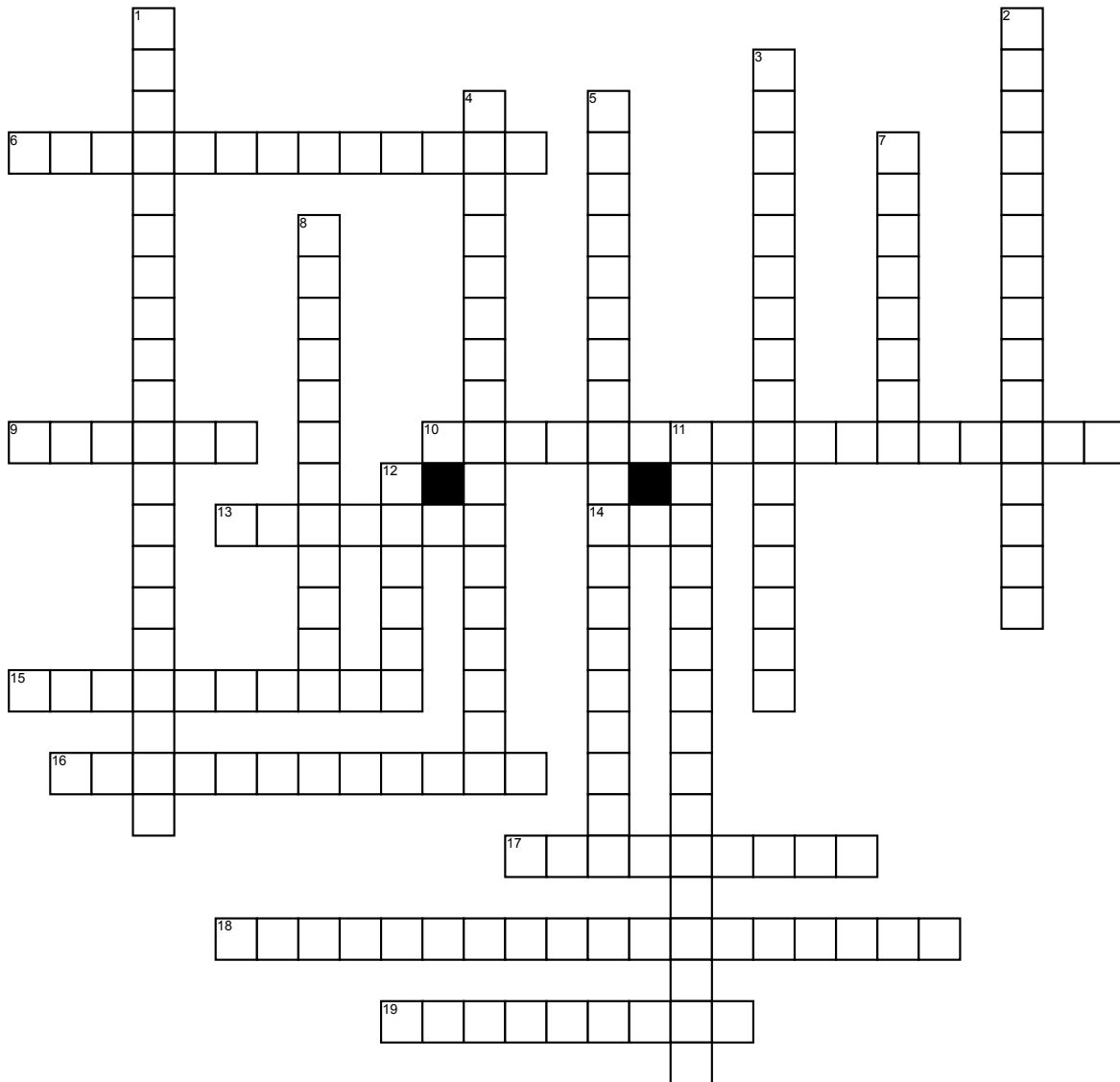


Anatomy

- 6. high blood glucose level
- 9. swelling of the neck from enlargement of thyroid gland
- 10. disorder in which the body does not produce enough growth hormone
- 13. defective mineralization of bones before epiphyseal closure
- 14. depressive symptoms in the winter or summer
- 15. anterior pituitary gland produces excess growth hormone in adults after epiphyseal plate closure at puberty
- 16. the overuse of steroids

- 17. severely stunted physical and mental growth due to untreated congenital deficiency of thyroid hormones
- 18. over production of aldosterone by the adrenal gland
- 19. condition characterized by excessive growth and height significantly above average in children

Down

- 1. premature sexual development
- 2. overactive thyroid gland
- 3. high blood pressure, abdominal obesity but with thin arms and legs due to prolonged exposure to cortisol

- 4. characterized by excessive thirst and excretion of large amounts of severely dilute urine
- 5. inability of cells to stimulate the development of male physiological characteristics
- 7. condition associated with hypothyroidism, including weight gain, mental dullness, and sensitivity to cold
- 8. low blood sugar
- 11. disorder in which the adrenal glands do not produce sufficient steroid hormones
- 12. diminished concentration of parathyroid hormone in the blood
