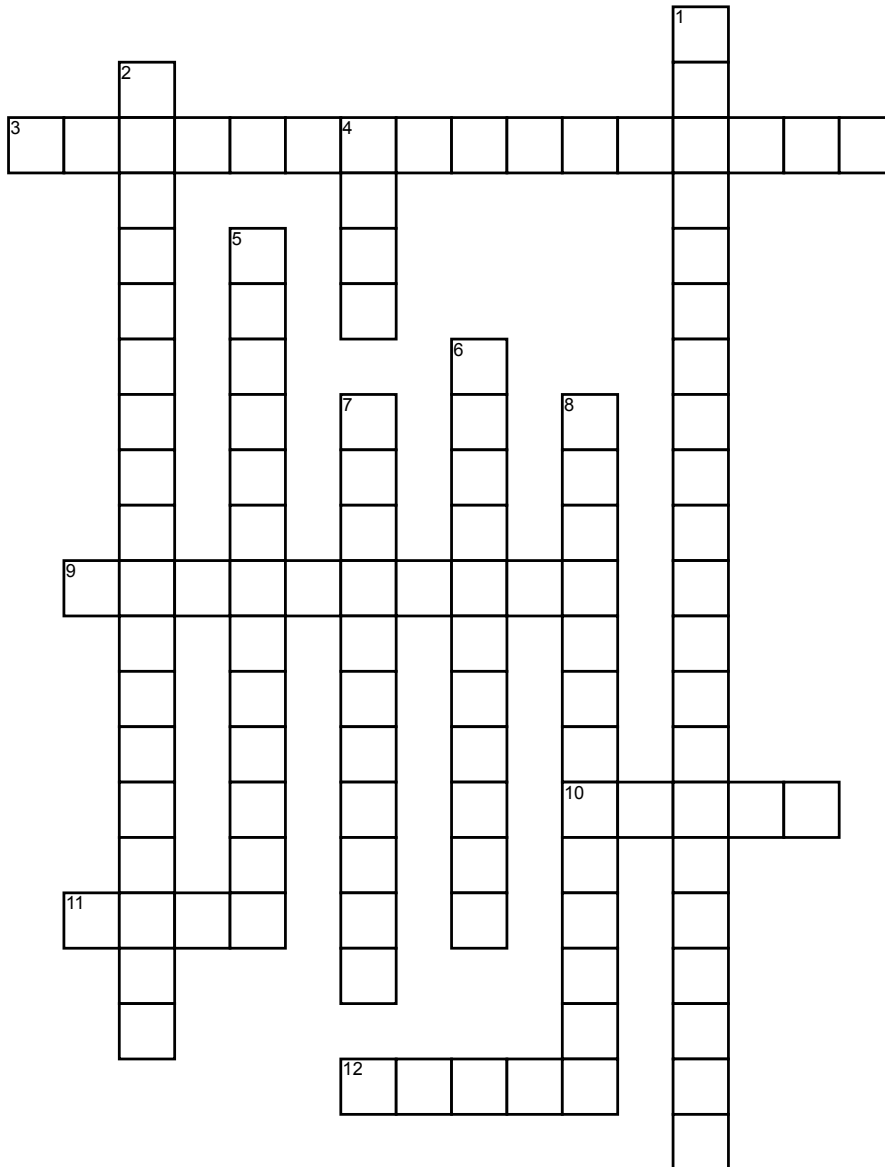


Anatomy of a Computer
