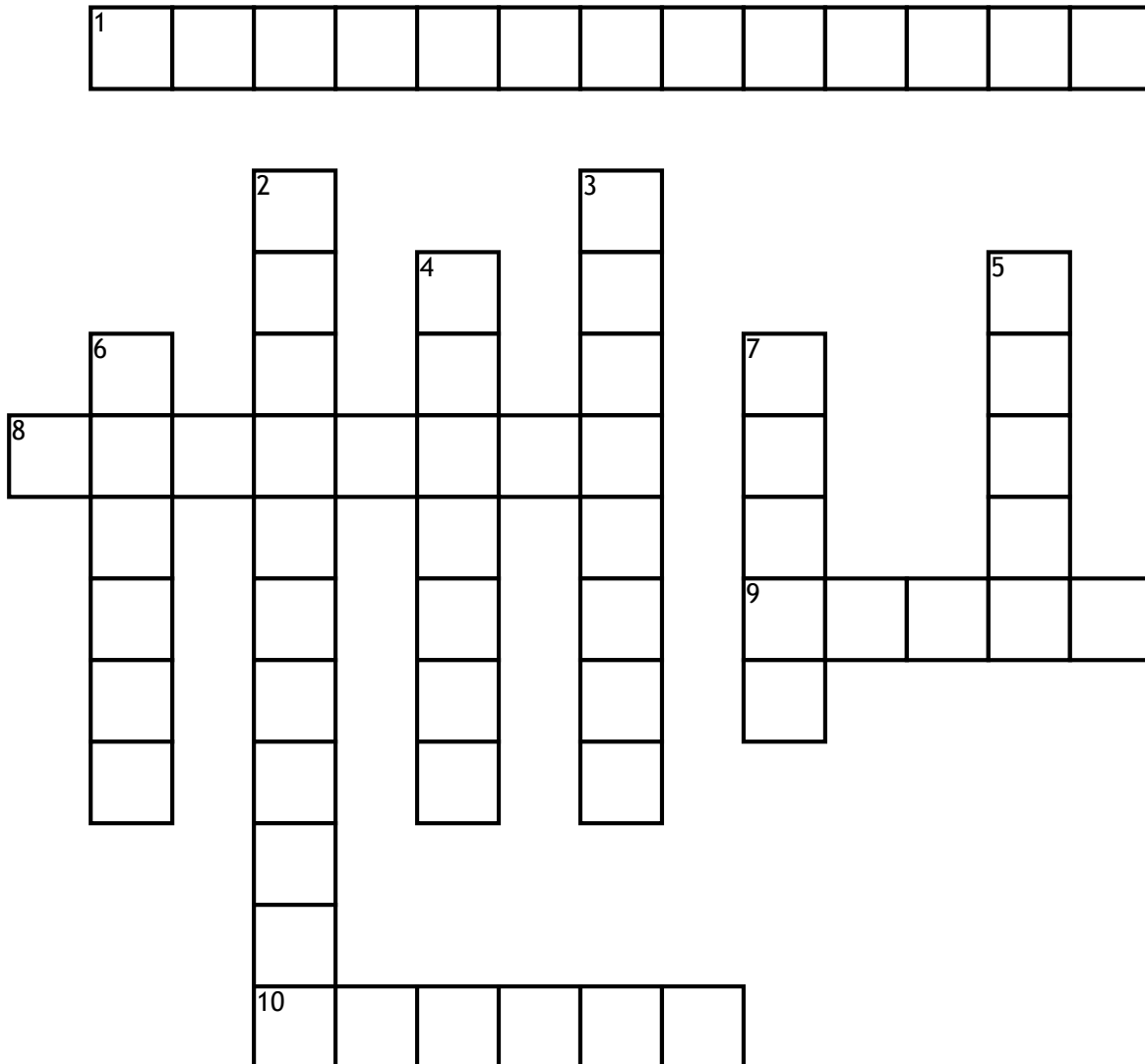

4. a ruler in Ancient Egypt. considered a god.

6. the third pharaoh of the Nineteenth Dynasty of Egypt. He is often regarded as the greatest, most celebrated, and most powerful pharaoh of the New Kingdom

7. the Egyptians removed all moisture from the body, leaving only a dried form that would not easily decay
