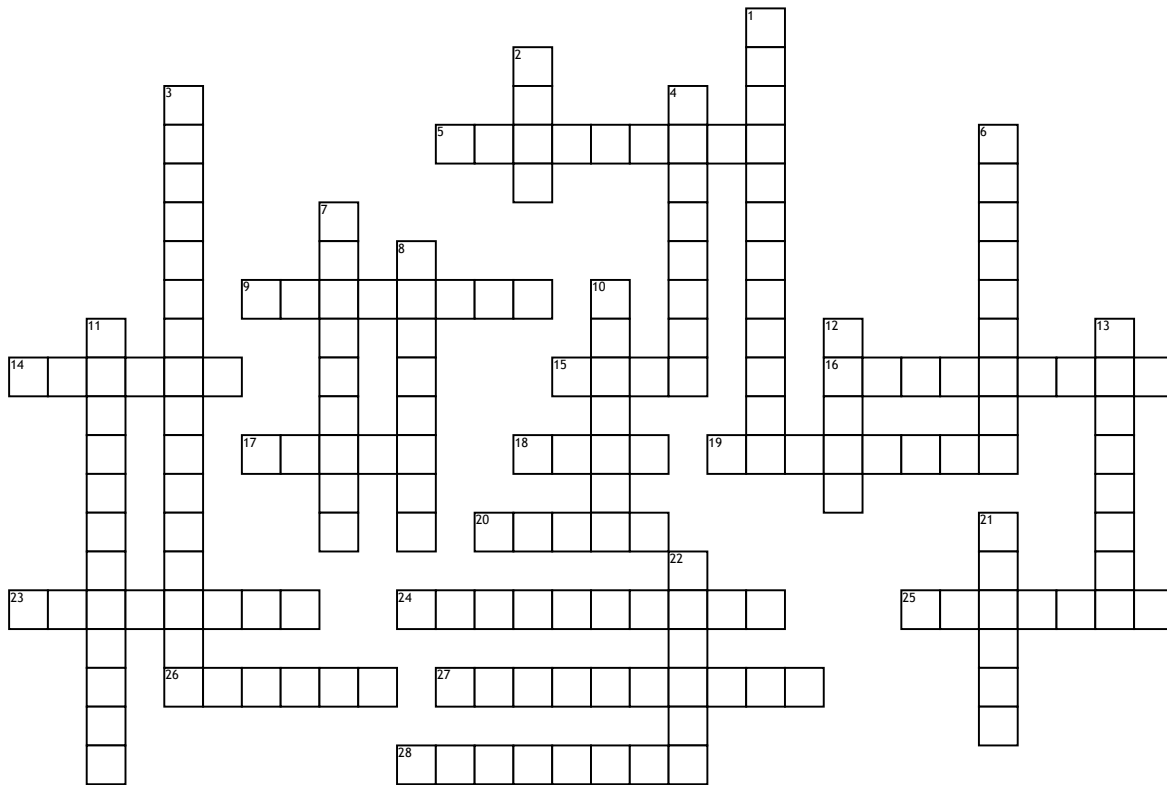


Ancient Greece Crossword Puzzle
