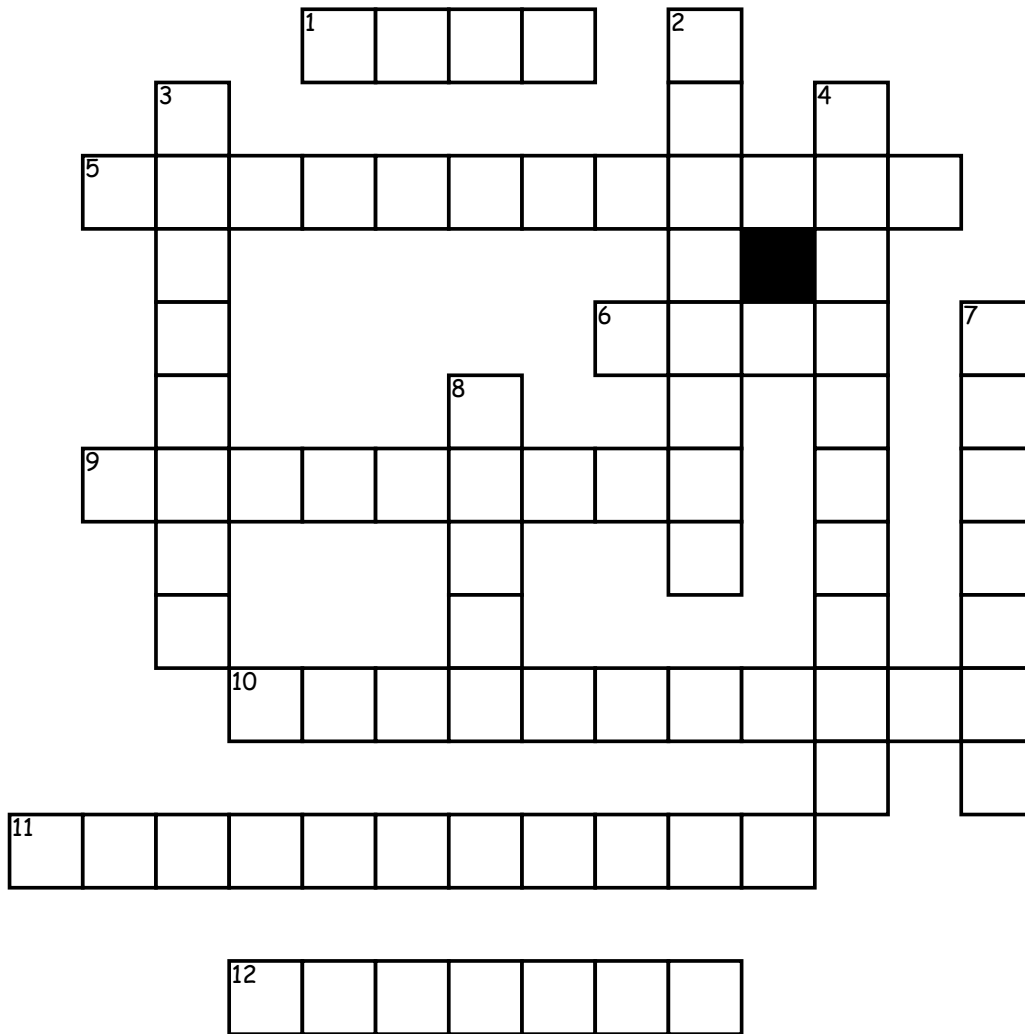

4. A major south-flowing river in South Asia. The total length of the river is 3,610 km (1,988mi) which makes it one of the longest rivers in Asia.
