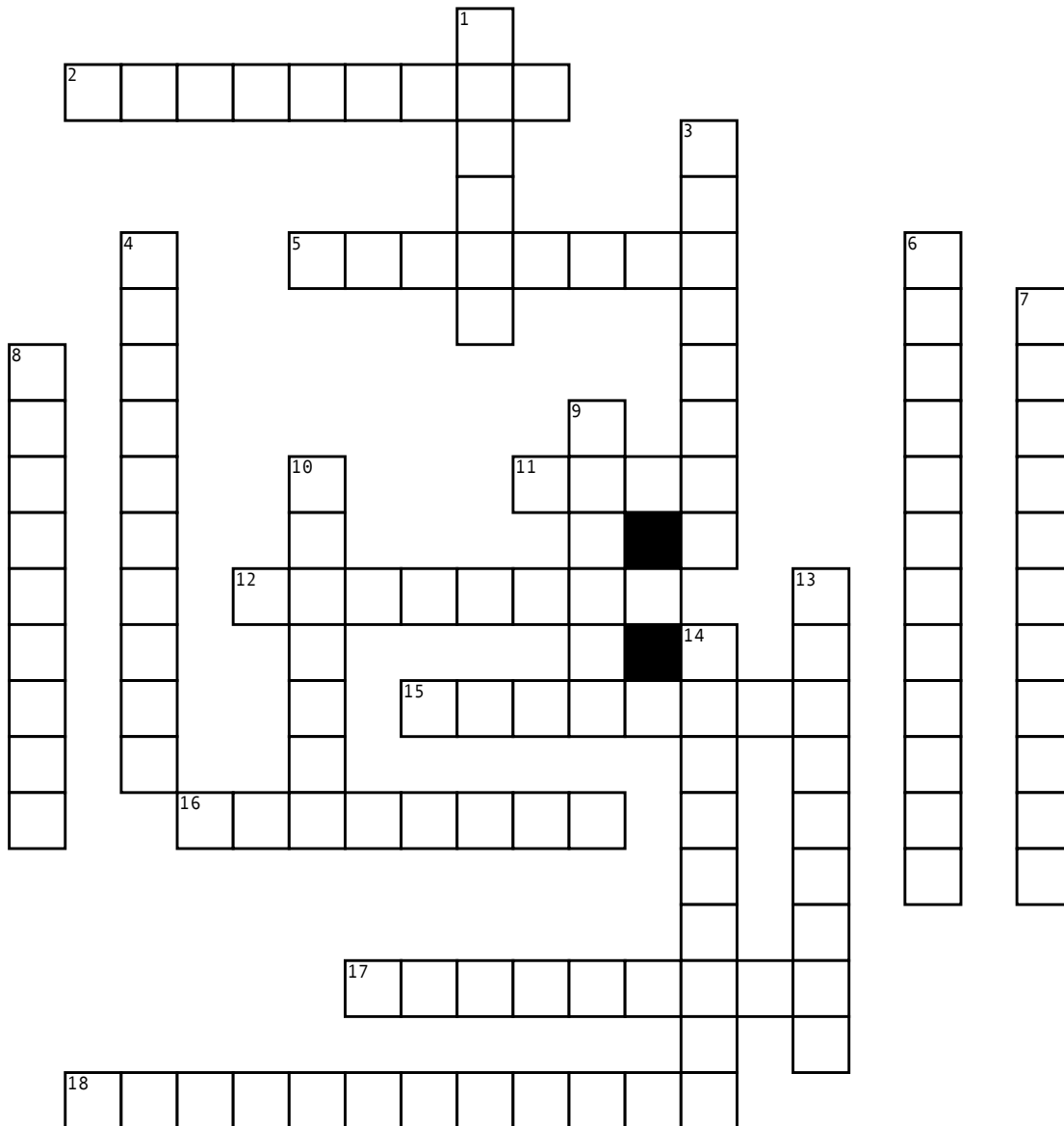


Ancient Rome Crossword Puzzle
