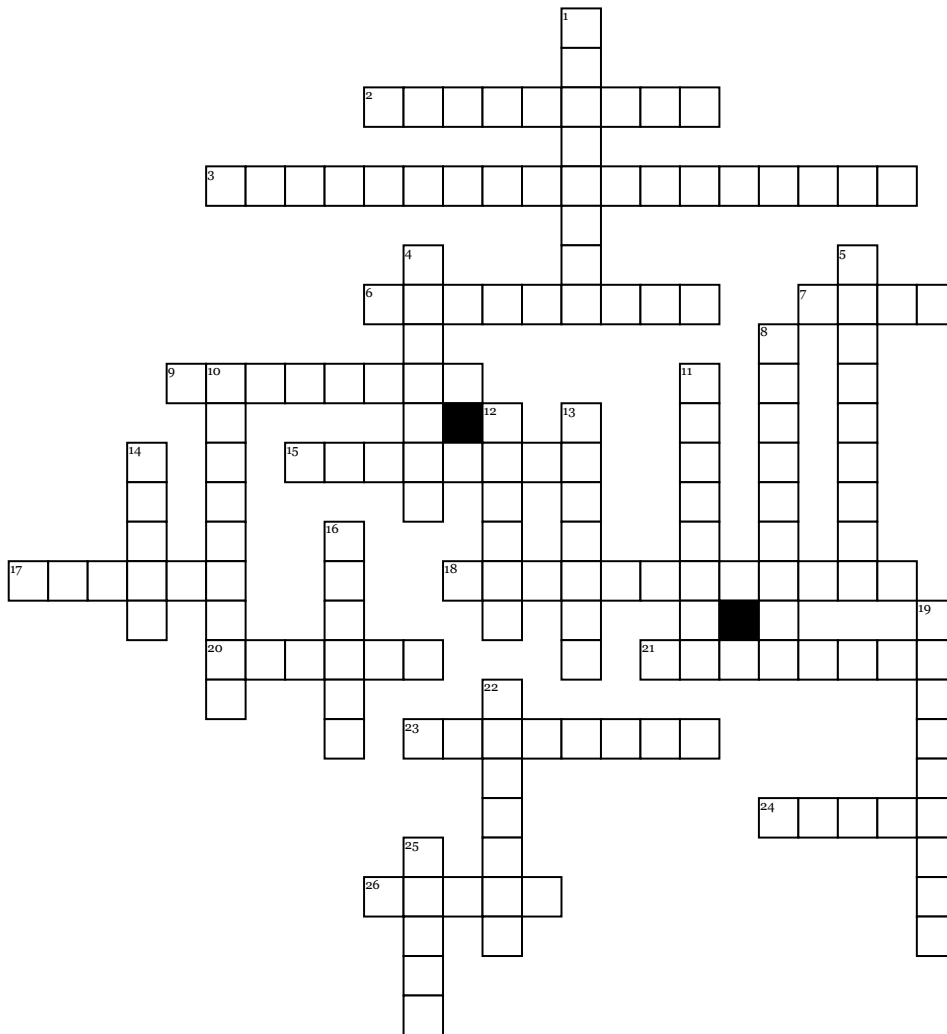


# Animal Farm Crossword Puzzle
