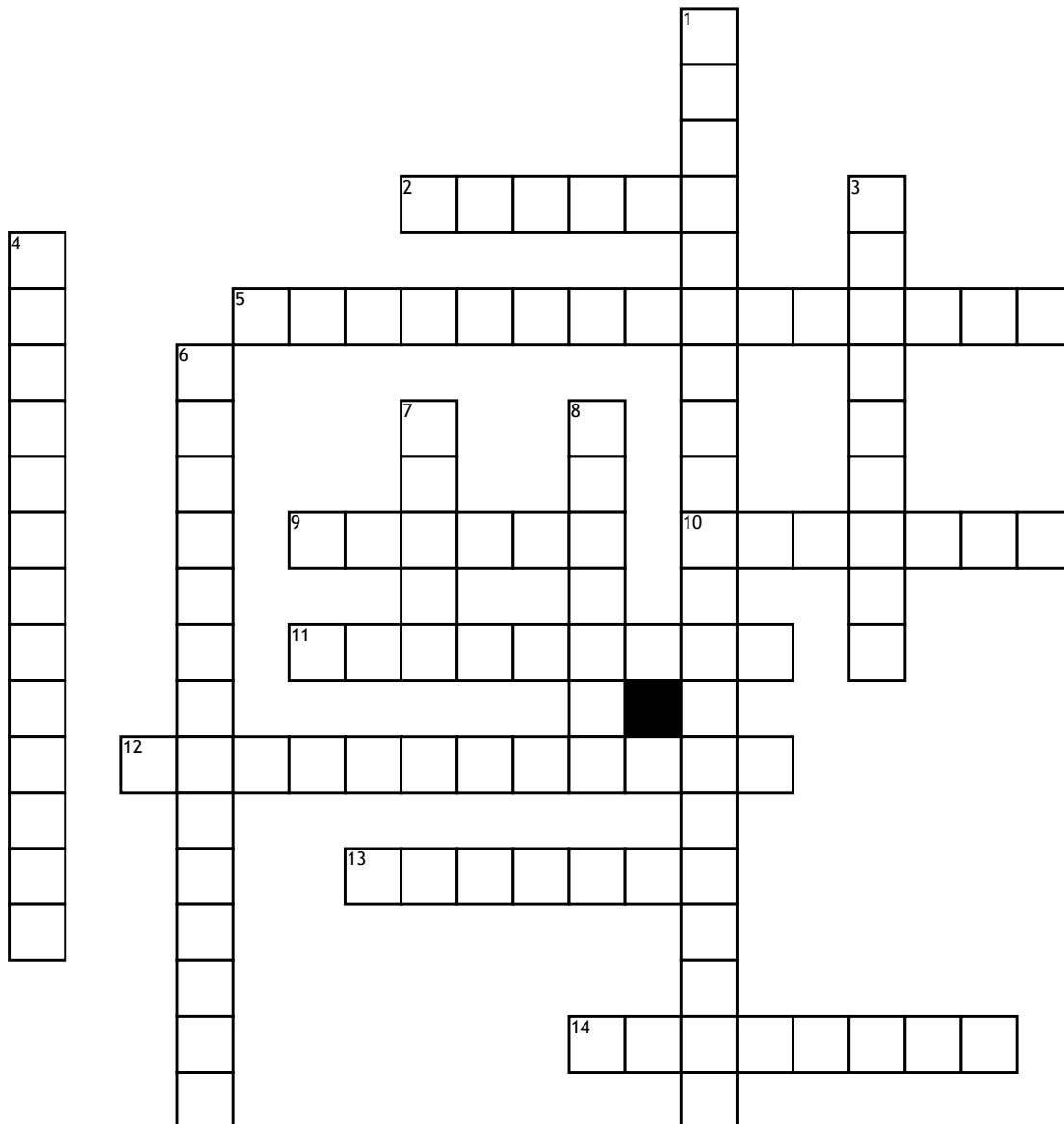

- 5. immediate, continuous physical control of a dog or cat at all times
- 9. premise where any person boards, breeds, buy, or letting for hire a fee dogs or cats
- 10. provision of and access to a three-dimensional structure having a roof, walls and a floor, which is dry, sanitary, clean, weatherproof and made of durable material.
- 11. keeping an animal or providing shelter food, etc. for 48 hours or more

- 12. a member of a dog, cat, or kennel club at any level who breeds on their private residence
- 13. to entirely neglect
- 14. dog used for defending

- 1. any animal or combination of animals that unreasonably annoys humans, endangers the life or health of other animals or person, etc.
- 3. any person who advertises or engages in the sale of one or more litters of dogs or cats per year to the public

- 4. any facility maintained by the county or organization for the confinement, care, control, or disposition of animals
- 6. accumulation of animals without providing the necessary means for them to live
- 7. any person possessing, harboring, keeping, or having control or custody of an animal
- 8. any cat or dog which is not in the obstructed sight and in the owners control
