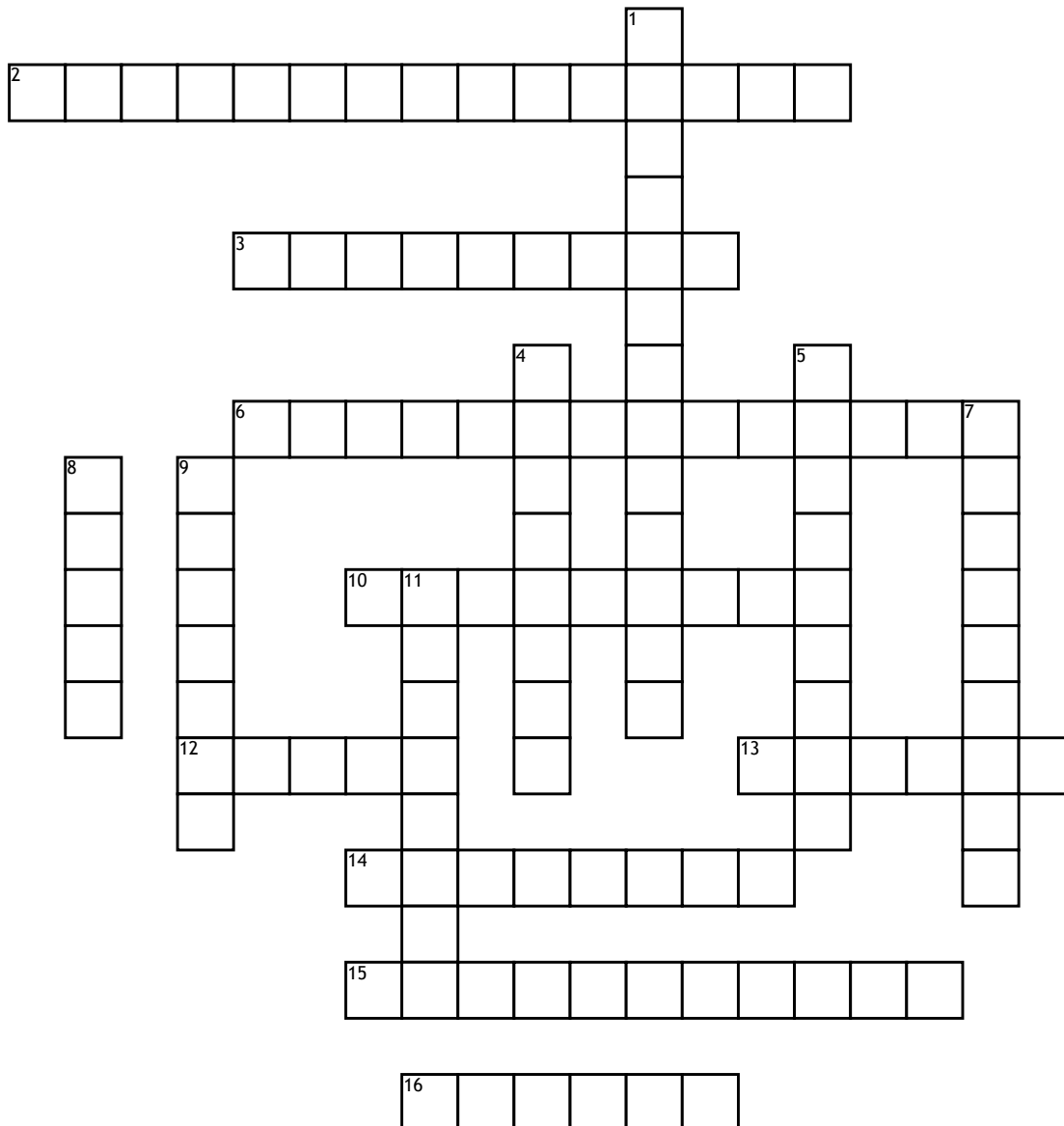

2. Smaller stature than mature females Examine genitalia to distinguish from young male animals
 3. White, erect ears, large litters, good feed efficiency
 6. Slower growing and have less muscle overall than the intact males Look for evidence of male genitalia such as a sheath to distinguish from females
 10. White to light straw colored Naturally Horned Originated in France
 12. Black, Polled, from Scotland

13. Color, size, degree of muscling, frame

14. Red and White face Horns Originated in England

15. Generally more muscular overall Typically larger in stature and grow faster than females Often exhibit more muscle in the neck area

16. Cream to light fawn color Smallest framed dairy breed

1. Large body structure than immature females Mammary glands more evident when the animal is not lactating

4. Long Body, good mothering ability, from Denmark

5. Black with a white belt, erect ears

7. Not set color pattern Large frame

8. Red, Dropped ears

9. Light Gray to Black or Red Originated in India
