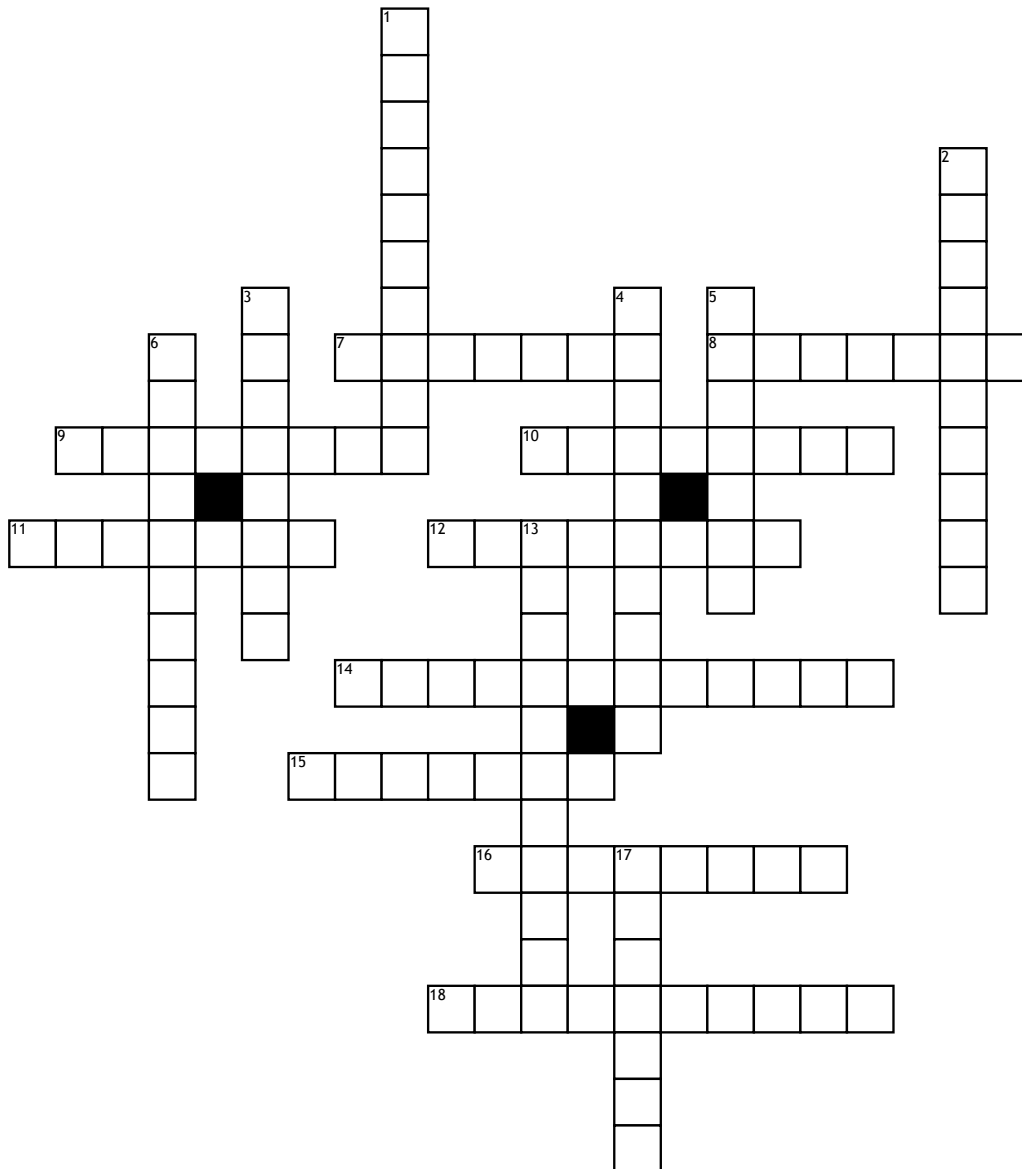


Anticoagulation

7. Has its own unique reversal agent
 8. BID maintenance dosing
 9. Generic of anticoagulant with no indication for joint replacements
 10. 1 of 2 oral agents with a black box warning for hematomas in patients receiving epidurals
 11. Parenteral anticoagulant that dose not require renal adjustment
 12. May casue Purple Toe Syndrome

14. parenteral direct factor Xa inhibitor

15. Used for warfarin bridging
 16. Oral agent with the longest average half-life
 18. Unique creatinine clearance that is a contraindication for Savaysa

1. 2nd of 2 oral agents with a black box warning for hematomas in patients receiving epidurals
 2. Agent that is only indicated for critically ill inpatient patients

3. Of the reversal agents; it's the cheapest and used PO or IV
 4. Generic of anticoagulant with indication for Hip but Not knee replacements
 5. Measured in units rather than milligrams
 6. Discontinued Twenty-Four hours prior to major procedure
 13. Has an indication for use in Coronary Artery Disease and Peripheral Artery Disease
 17. Any dose above ----mg of Rivaroxaban should be taken with food
