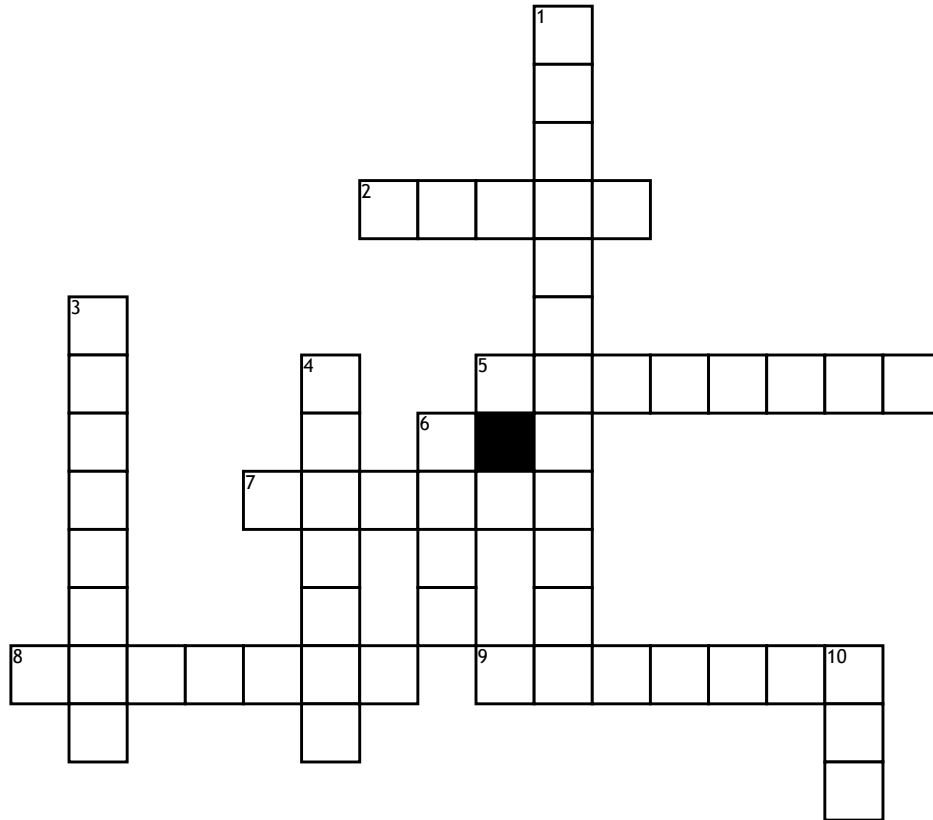


Anxiety Disorder Puzzle
