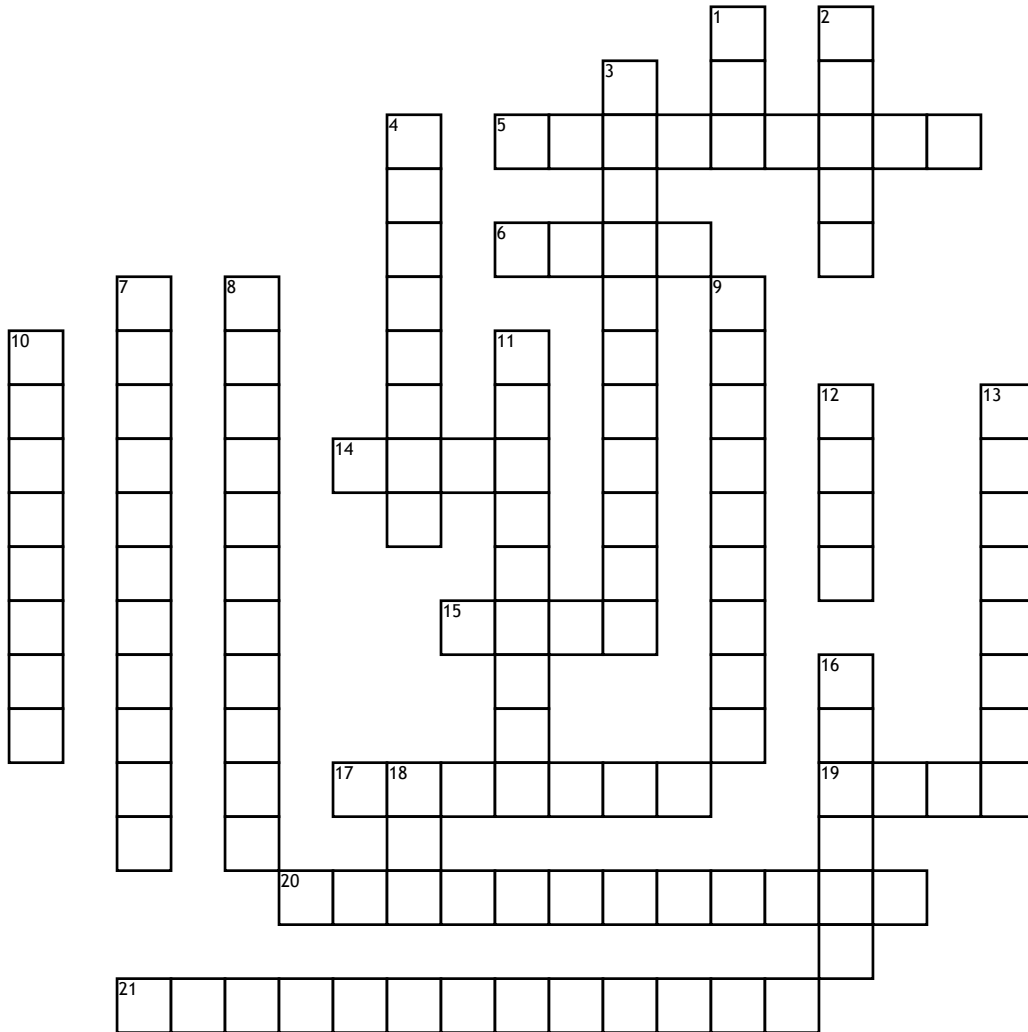


# Archery Terms Part 1



**Across**

- 5. The horizontal projection on the bow upon which the arrow lies
- 6. The side of the bow away from the bow string
- 14. To pull the bowstring back also the distance the bowstring is pulled back
- 15. Any backstop to which a target face is attached
- 17. A style of shooting without a bow sight
- 19. The ability of a bow to propel an arrow a given distance
- 20. A bow made of several materials
- 21. The material in the center of the bowstring where the arrow is knocked. Protects the string from wear

**Down**

- 1. A device made of a piece of flexible material with a string connecting the two ends, used to propel an arrow
- 2. The colored bands around the shaft of the arrow which aid in its identification
- 3. The distance from the pivot point to the string when a bow is strung
- 4. A piece of stiff material, usually leather, used to protect the bow arm.
- 7. A device used to string a bow safely
- 8. A handheld hand drawn bow that uses a pair of cables and wheels to store more energy
- 9. A sharp, razor bladed arrow point used for hunting

- 10. An arrow point usually made of rubber and used in some archery activities
- 11. A T shaped device used to measure brace height and for placing not locators
- 12. To tilt the bow left or right while at full draw
- 13. A mechanical device placed on the bow which the archer uses for aiming at the target
- 16. Consistent placement of the drawing hand to a position on the face, mouth or jaw
- 18. Any method used to point the arrow in the direction you want it to go
