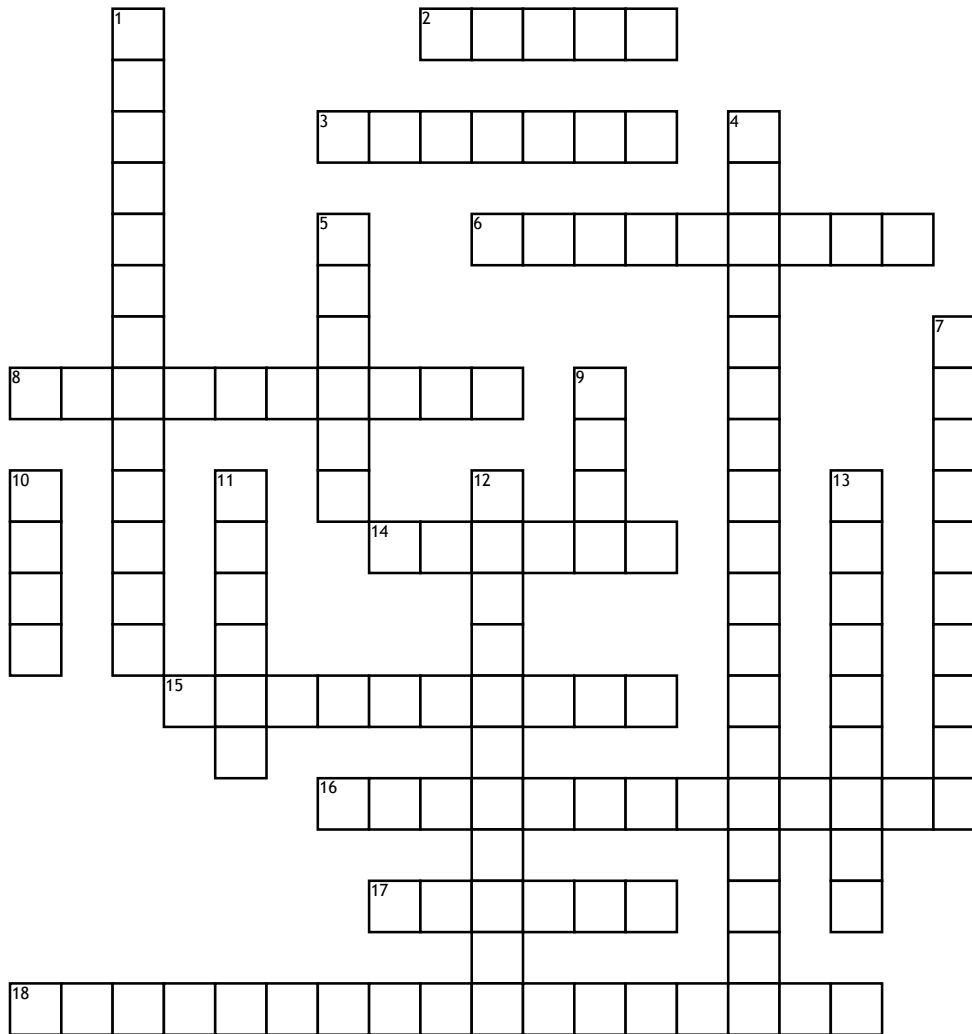


Architecture & Construction Terms
