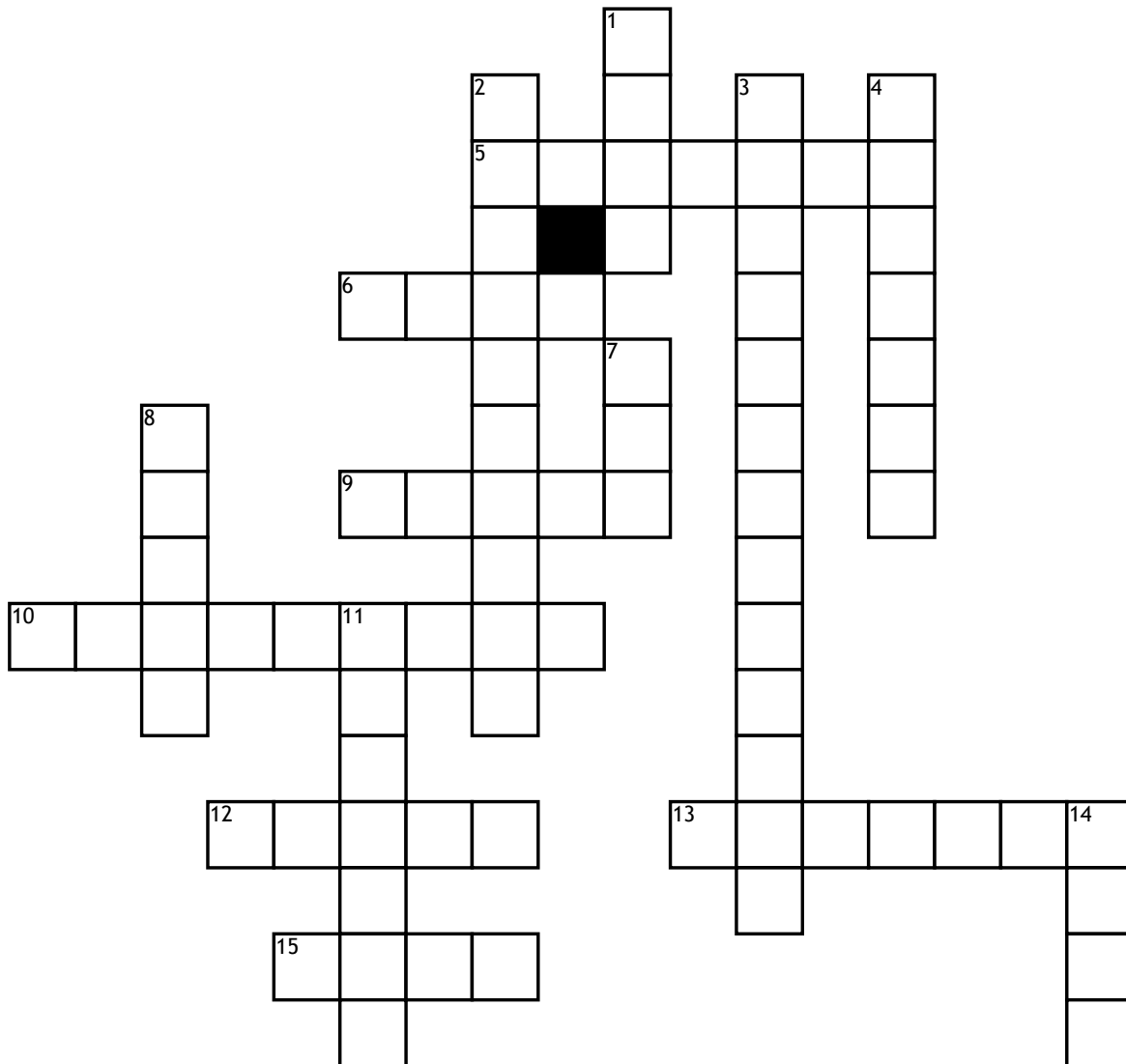


Art Crossword - Line, Color, Shape, and Form
