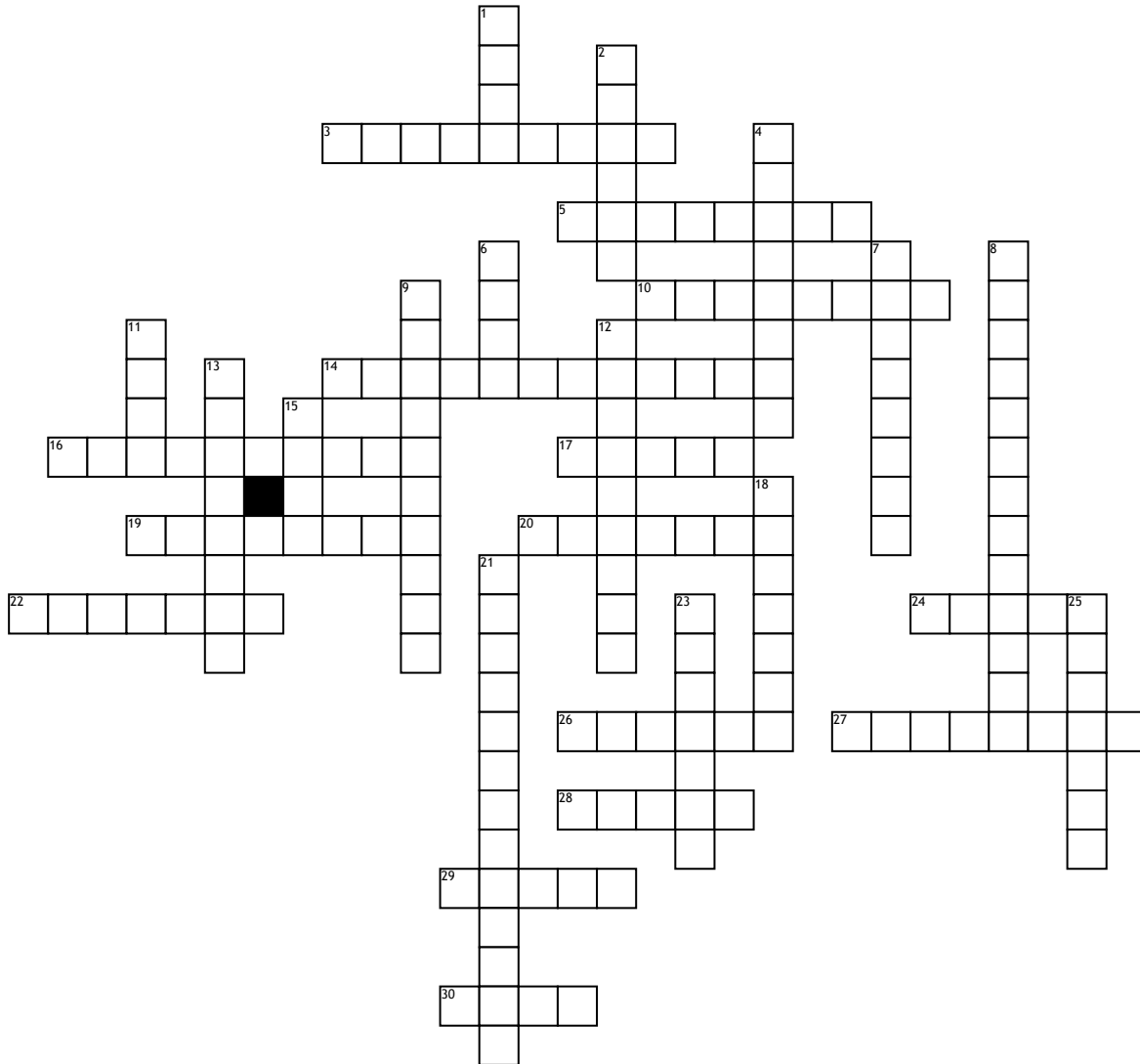


Assipattle and the Stoorworm
