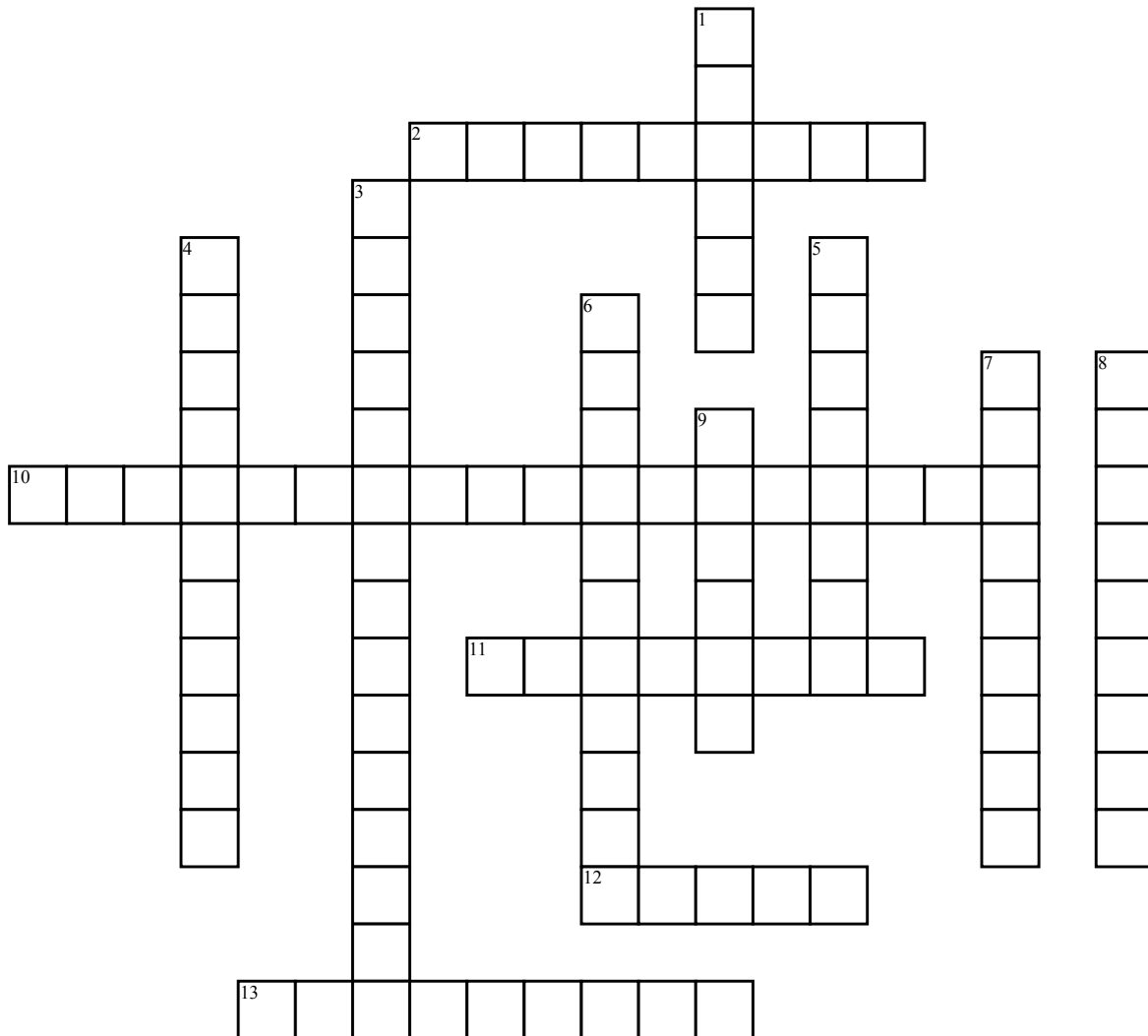


Astronomy Crossword Puzzle
