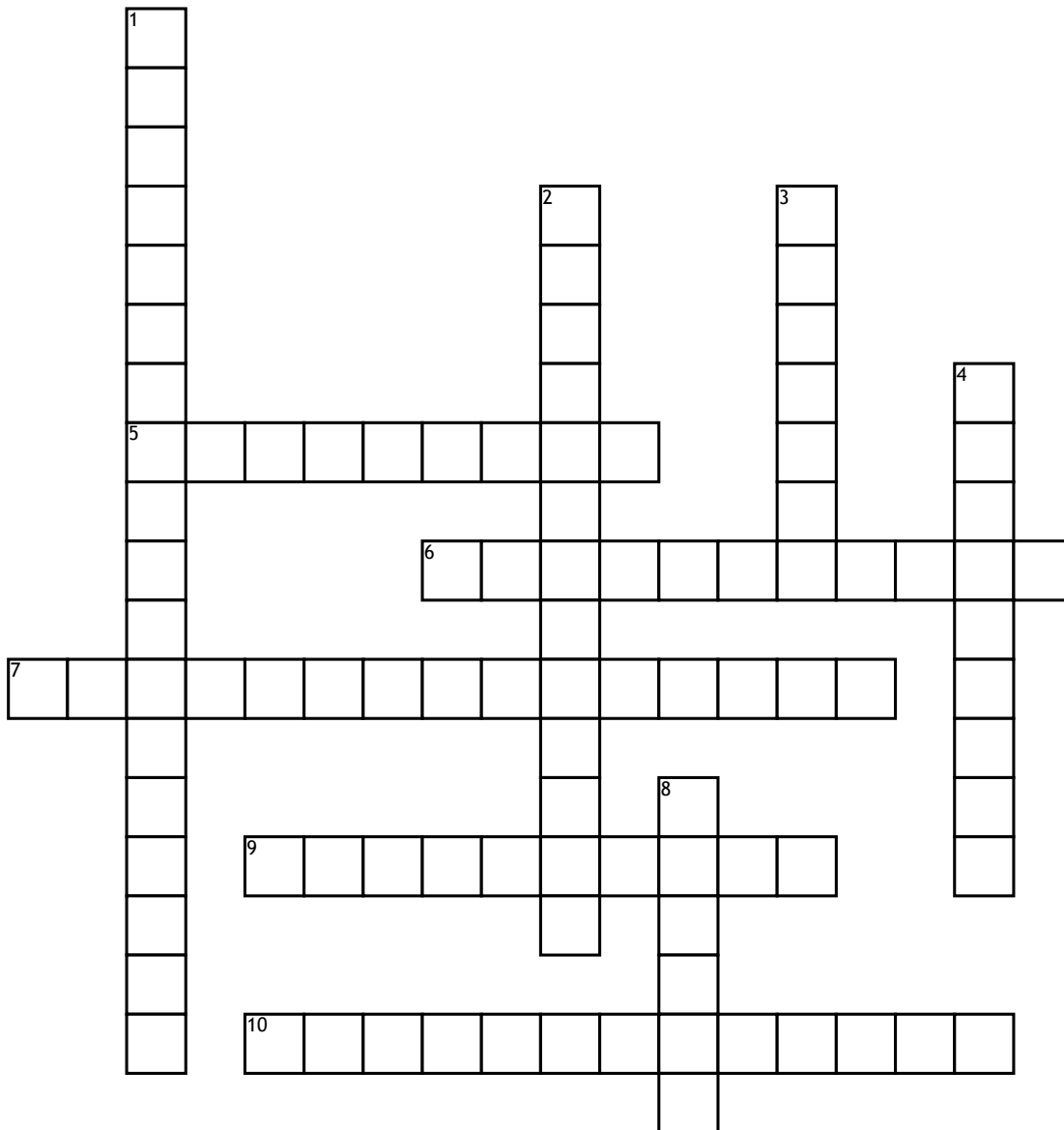


# Atmospheric Conditions
