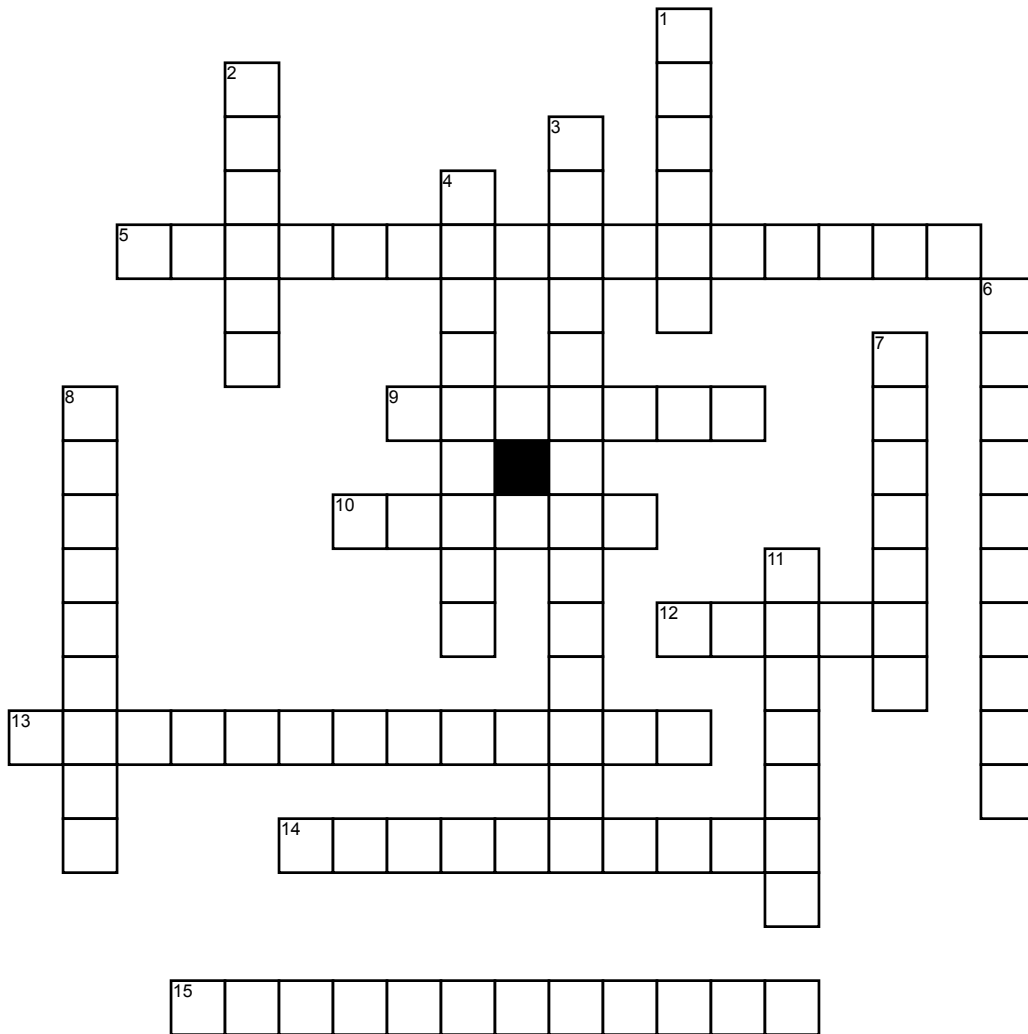


Australia Crossword Puzzle
